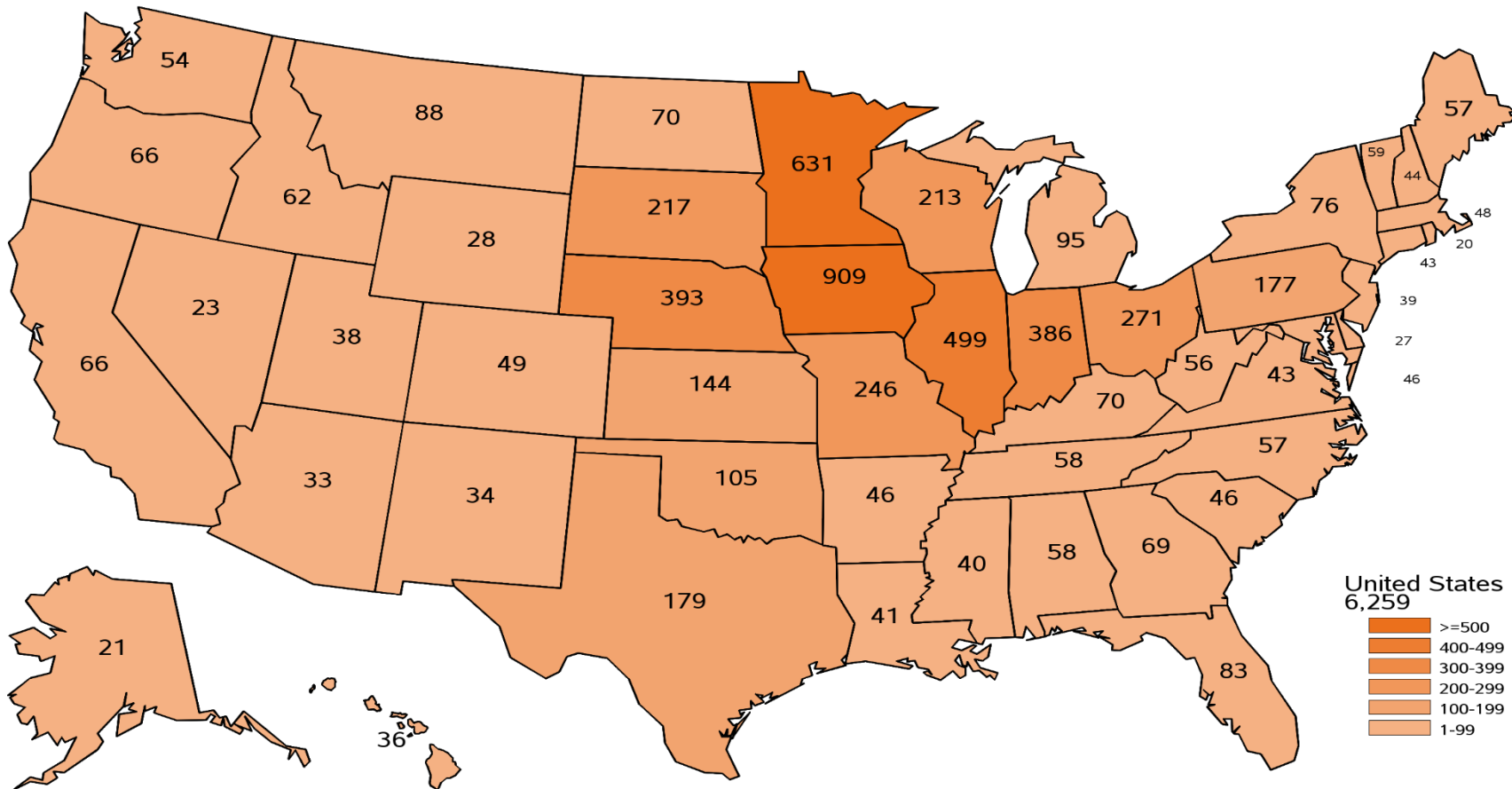

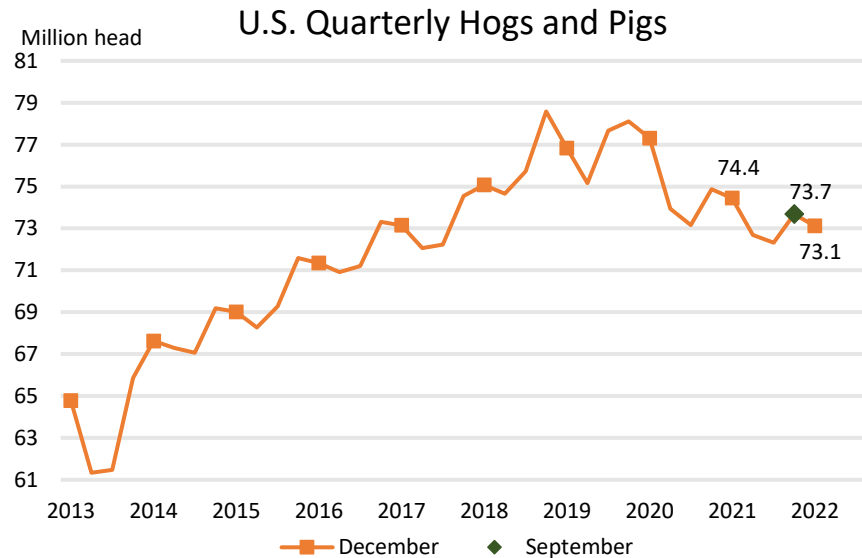

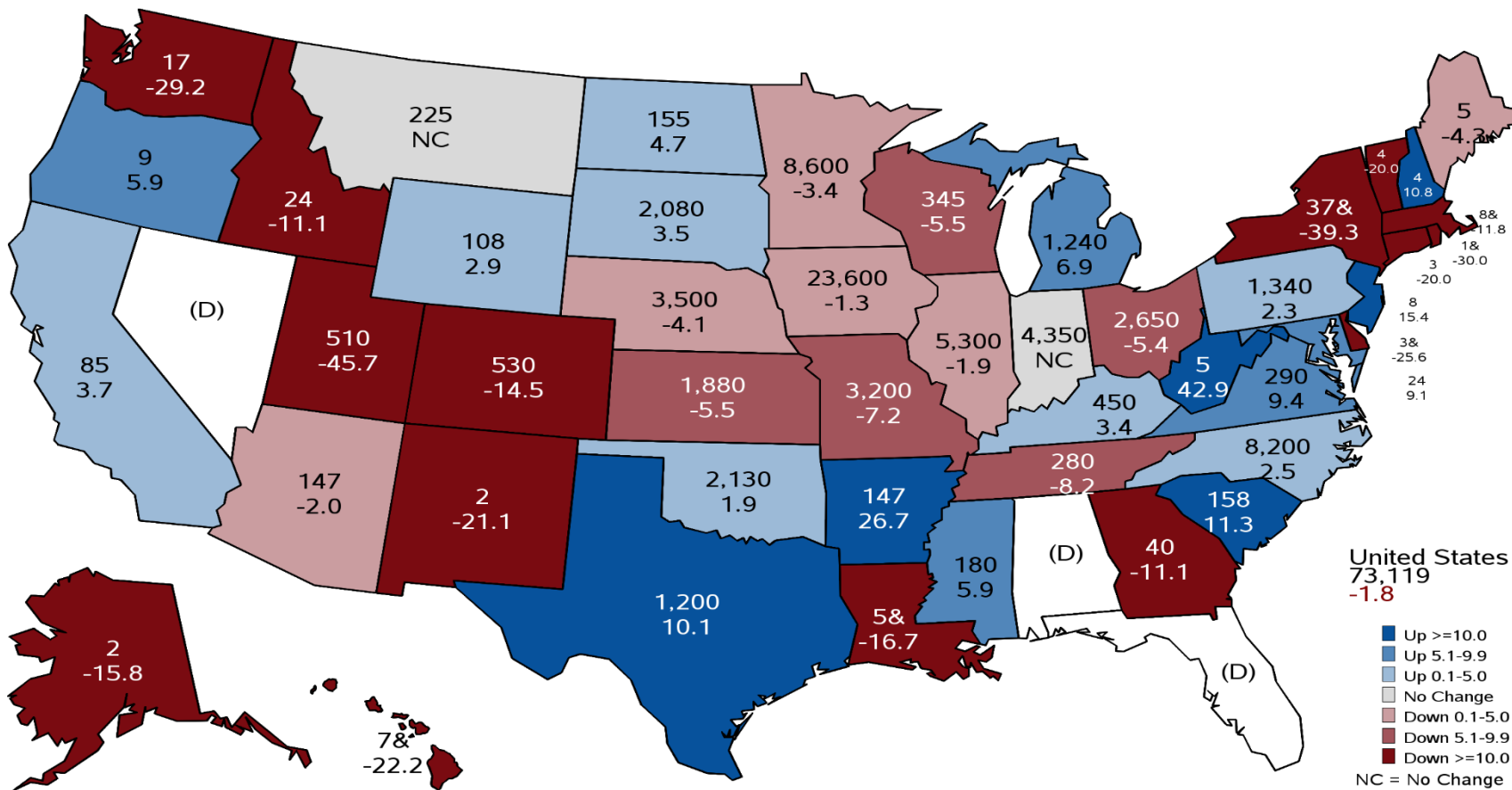

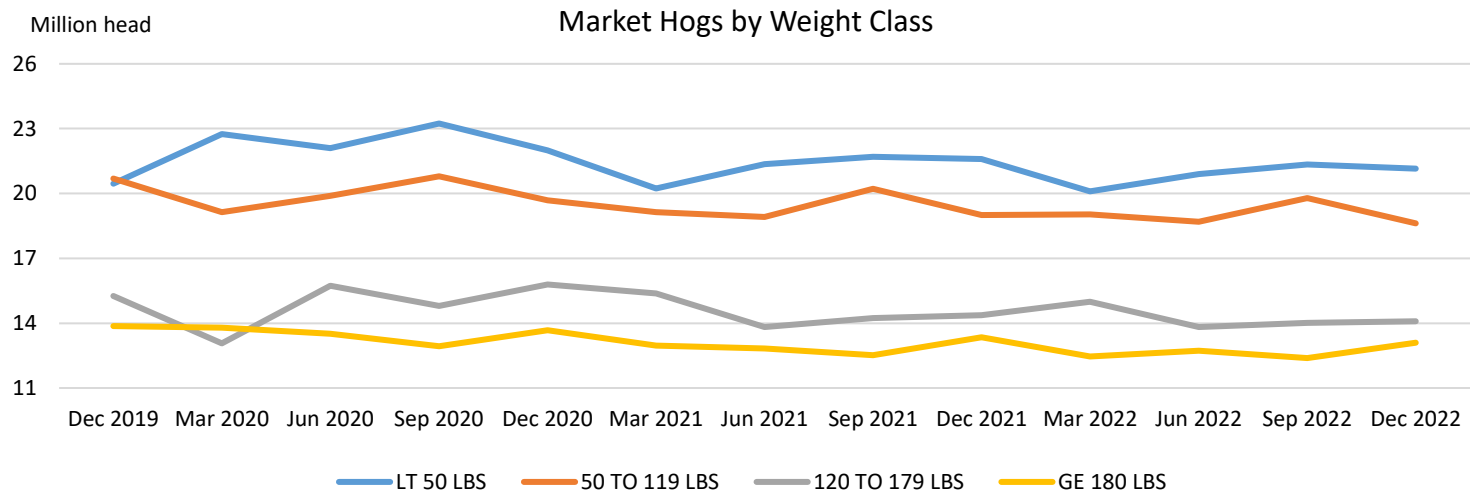

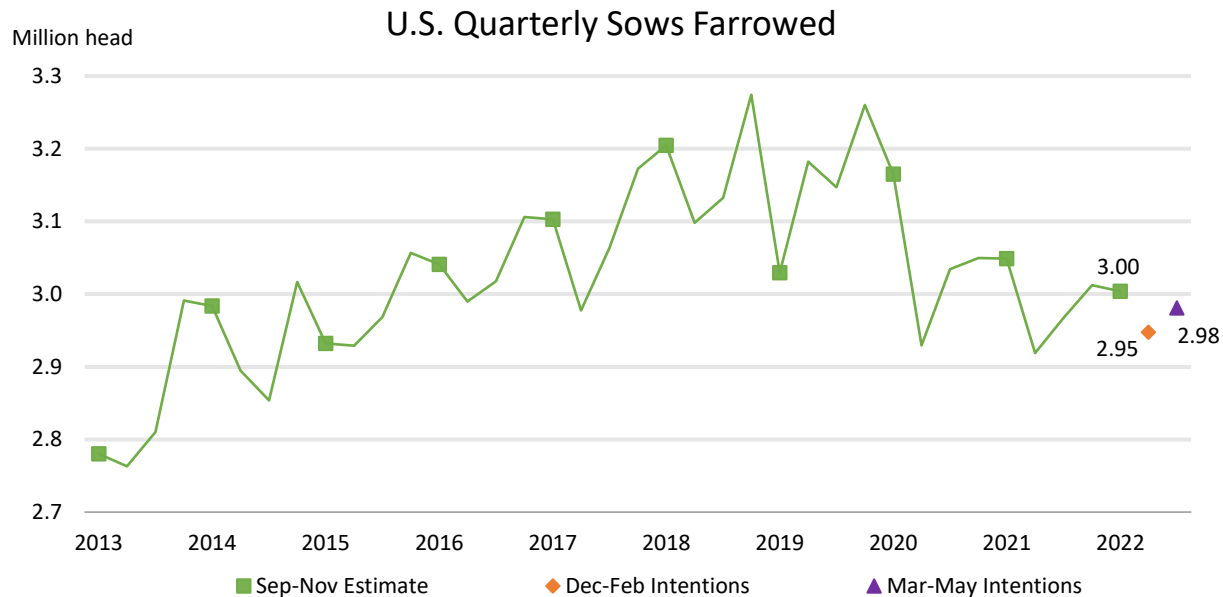

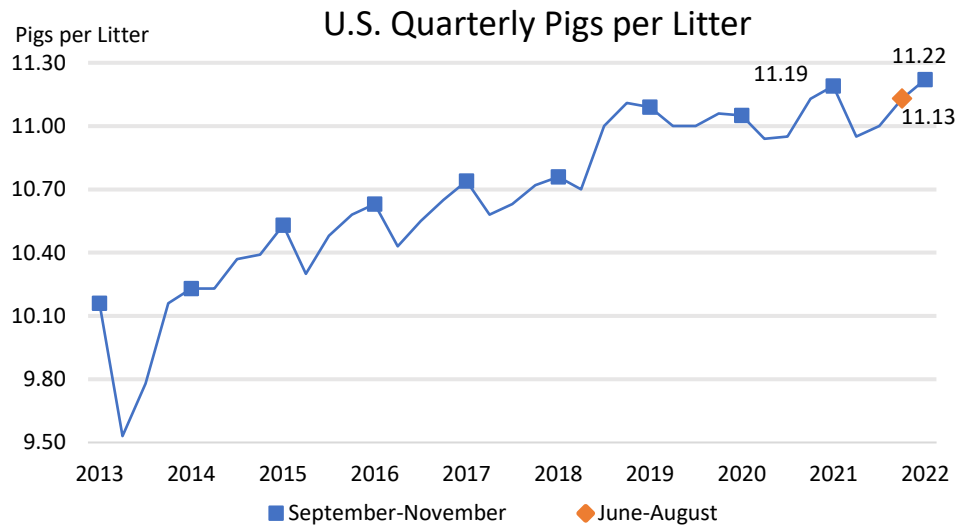

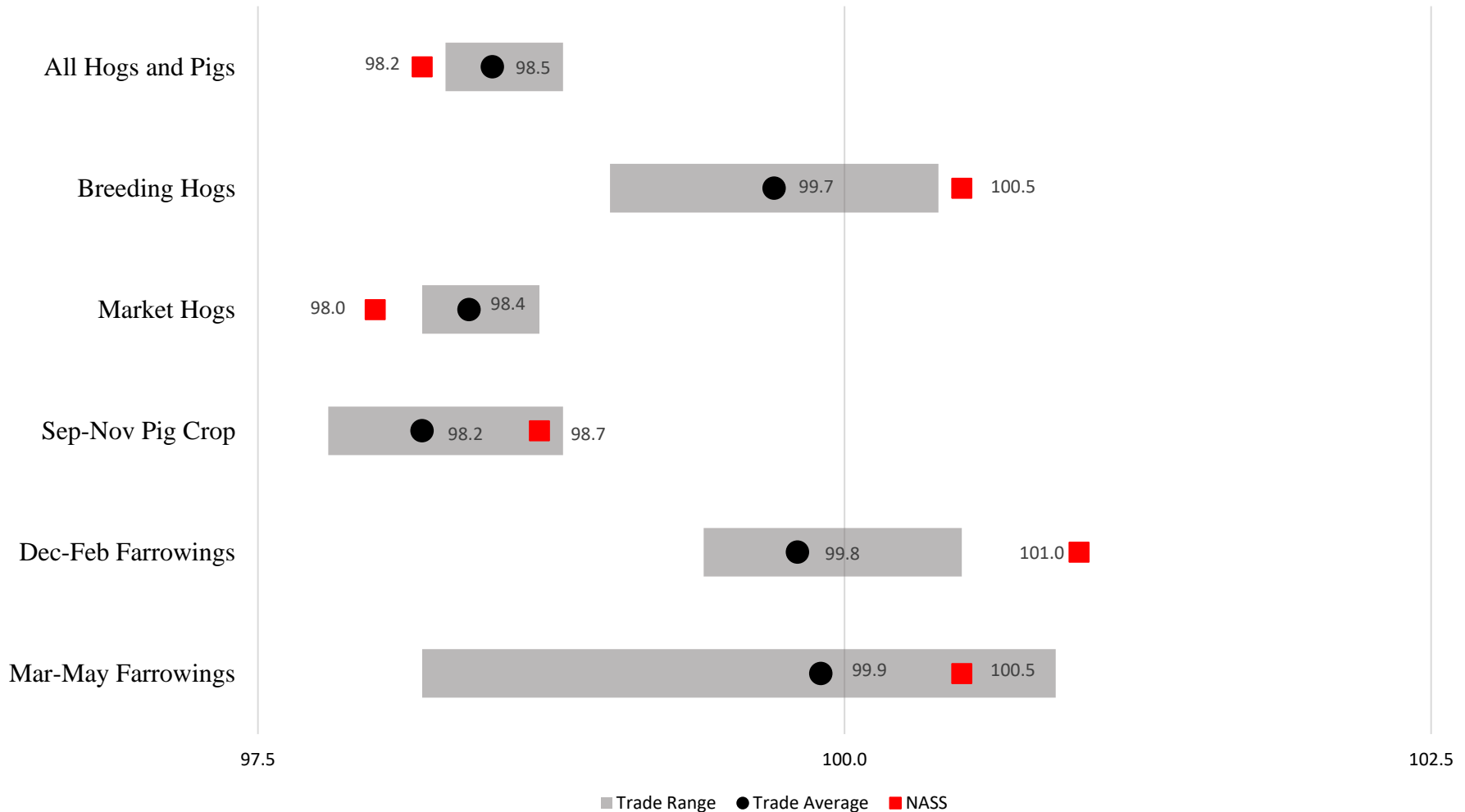

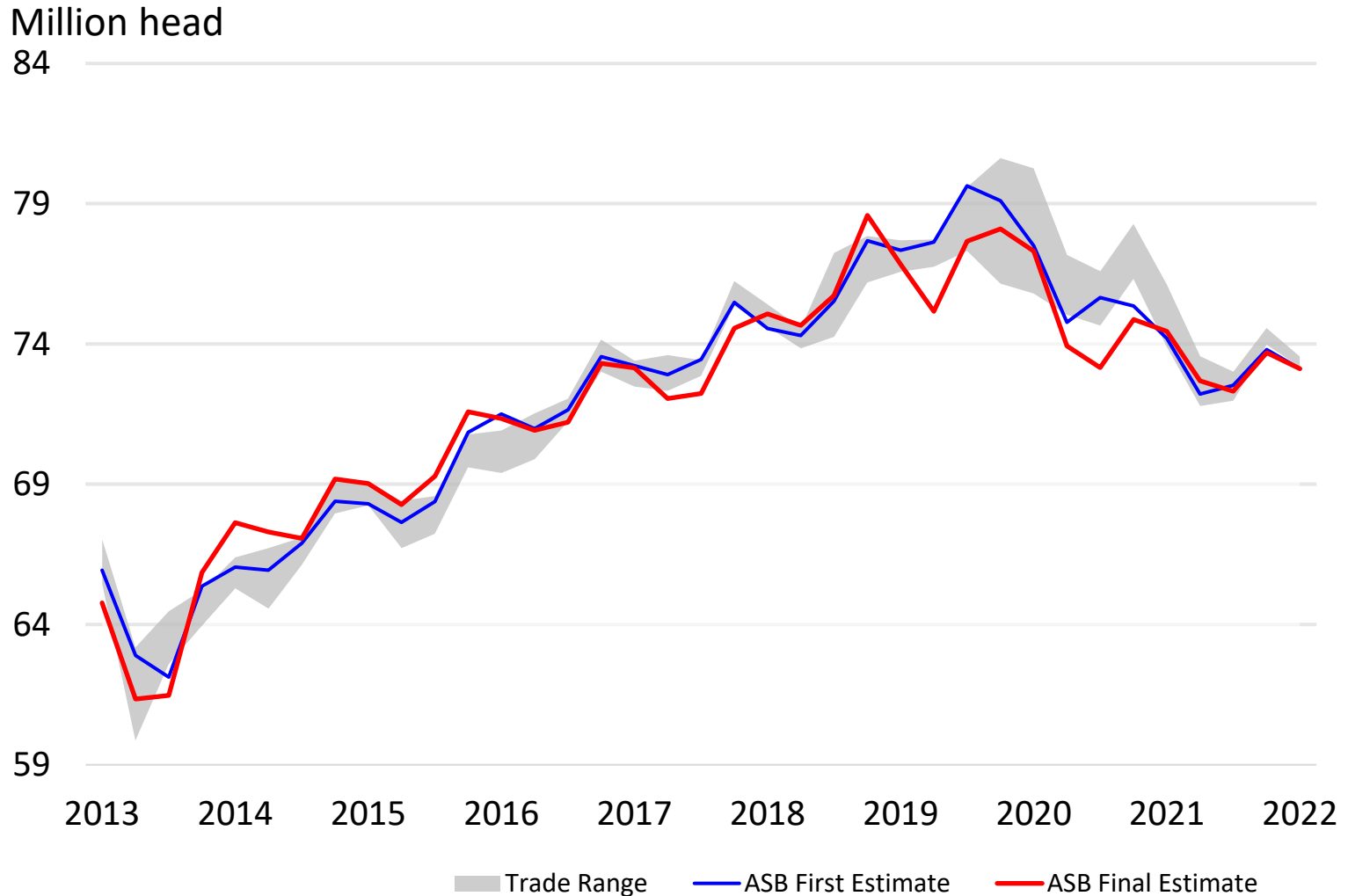


Trade Expectations Compared to NASS Estimates Percent of Previous Year

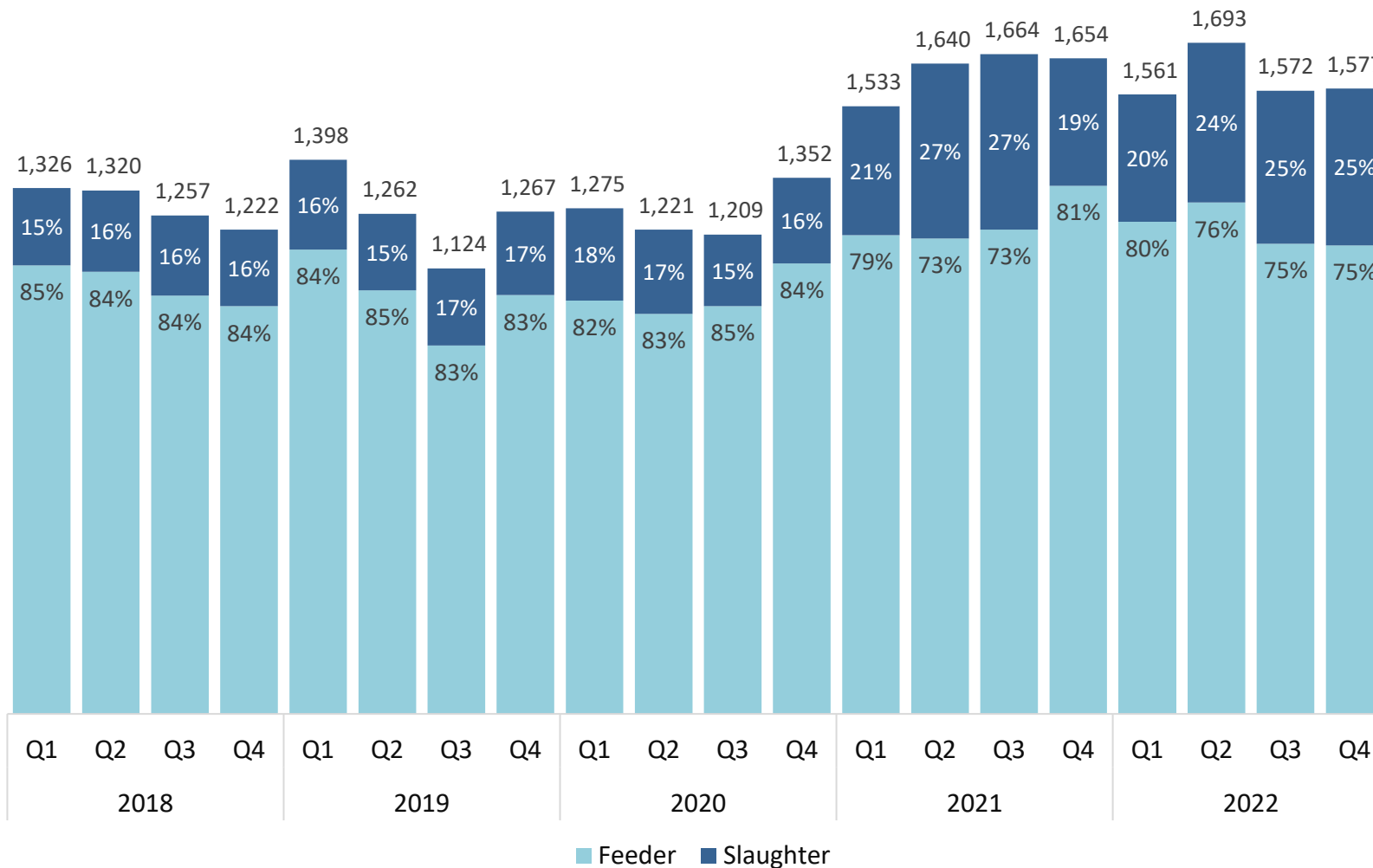

Canadian Imports by Quarter

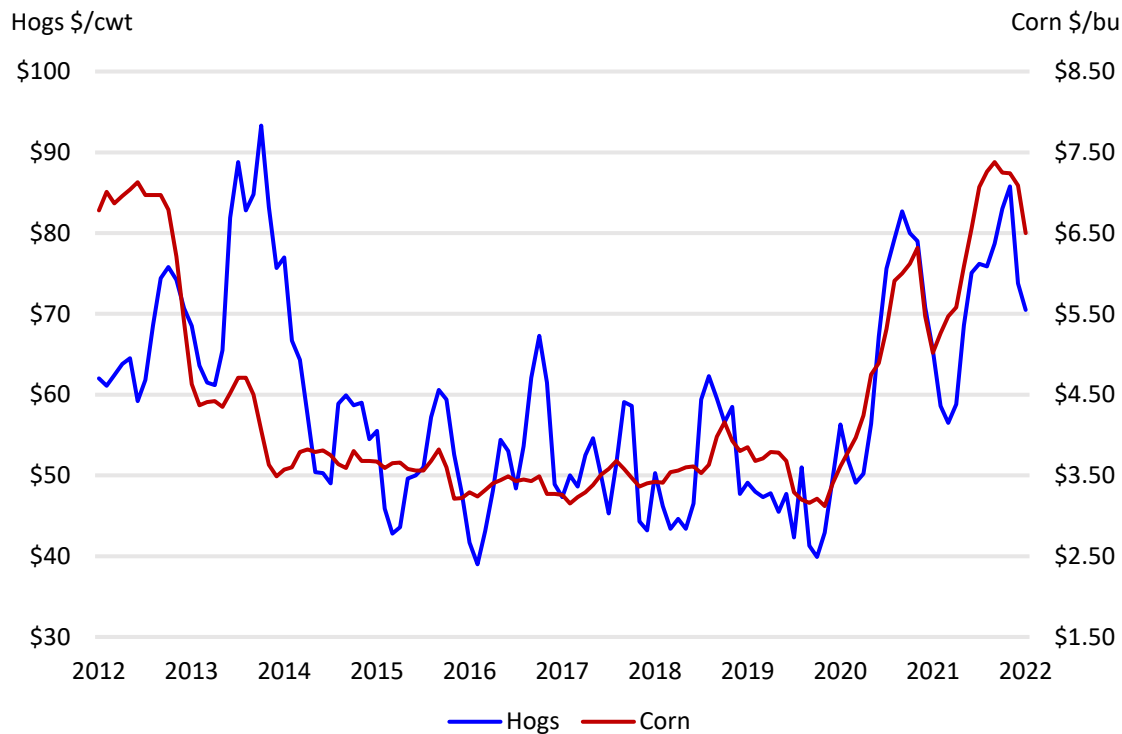
