






United States Winter Wheat Condition



Percent Rated Good to Excellent






United States Winter Wheat Progress










Winter Wheat Harvested-to-Planted Ratio






May 2023 Winter Wheat Harvested Acres



Bushels and Percent Change from Previous Year






White Winter Wheat Production United States






2023 U.S. Winter Wheat Production





Thousand Tons and Percent Change from Previous Year




