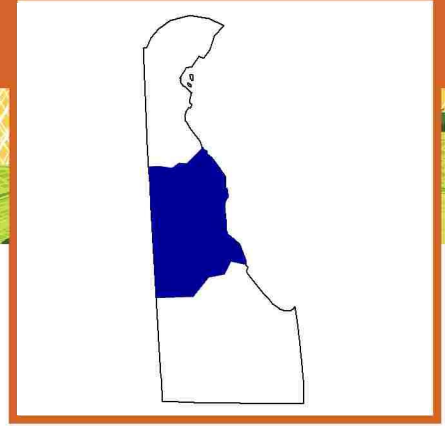

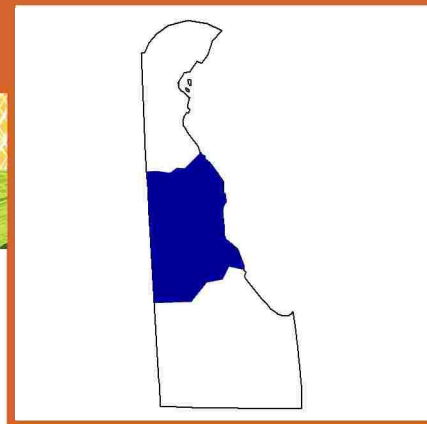

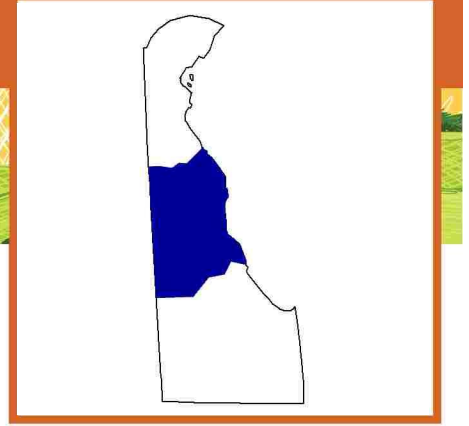

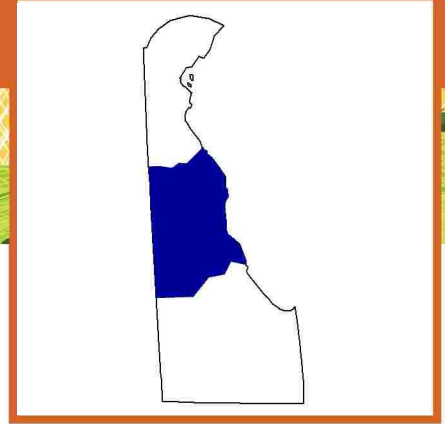


Kent County, Delaware Farms with White Producers^a



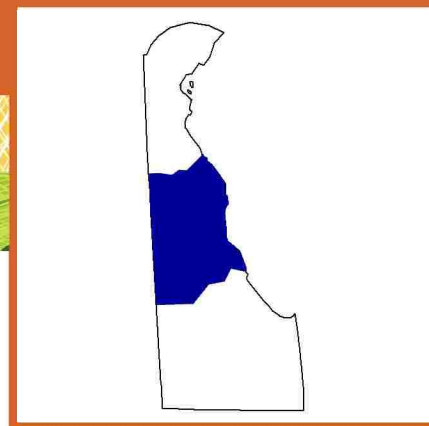
