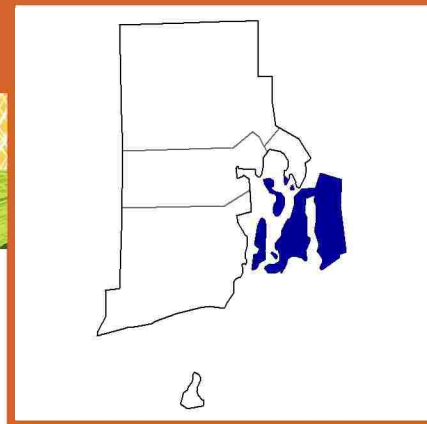
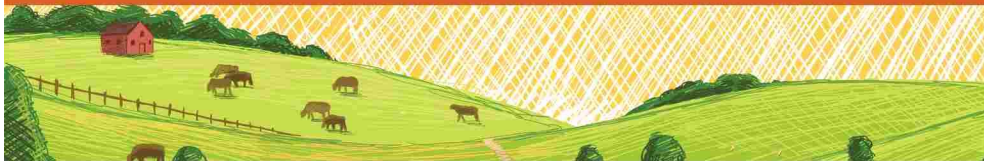


Newport County, Rhode Island Farms with Asian Producers^a

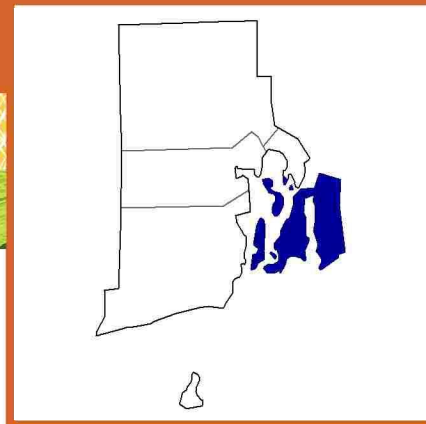

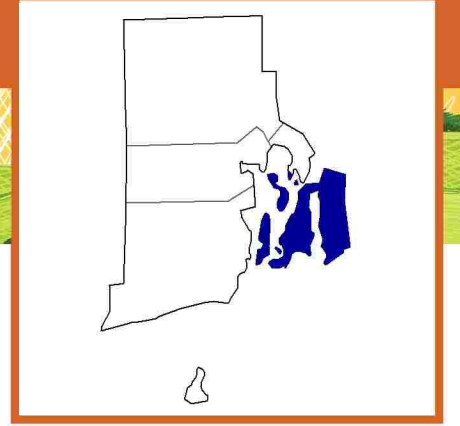

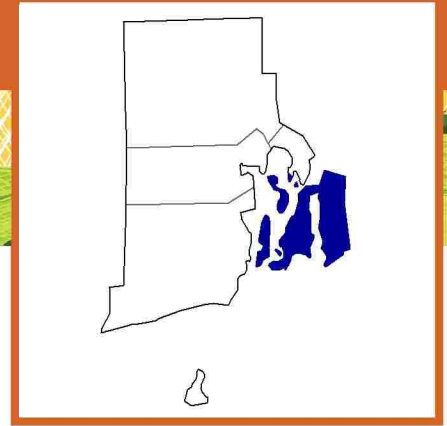

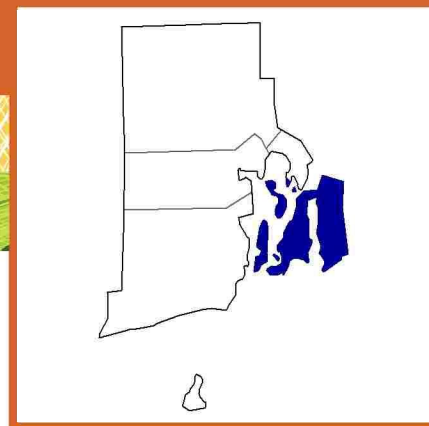
