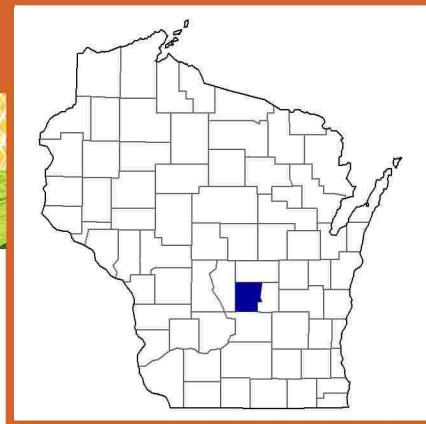




Marquette County, Wisconsin Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers^a

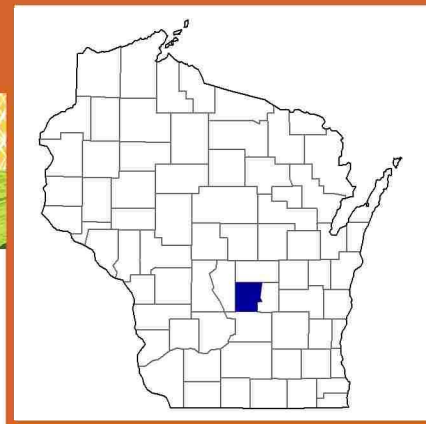

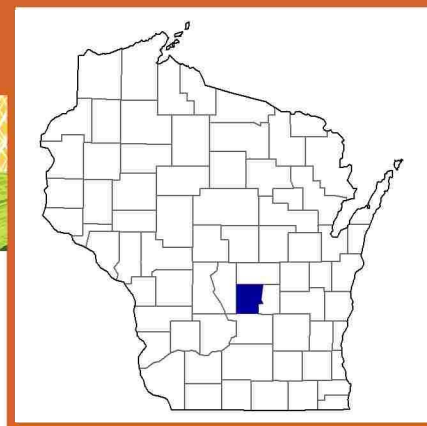
