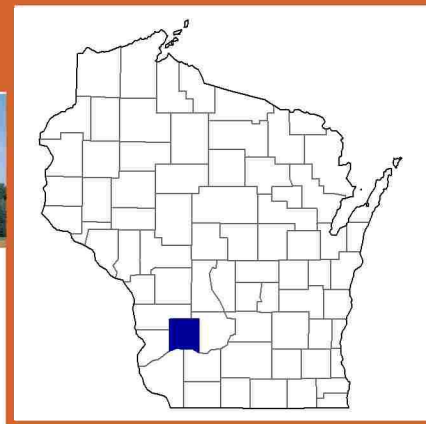
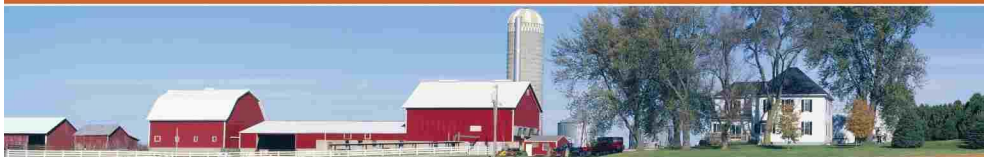


Richland County, Wisconsin Farms with Asian Producers^a

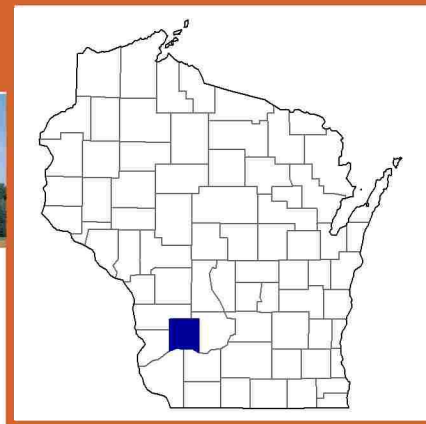

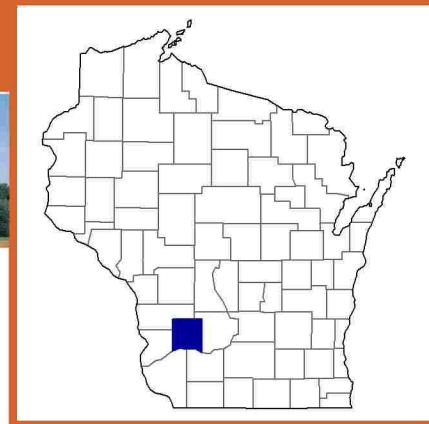

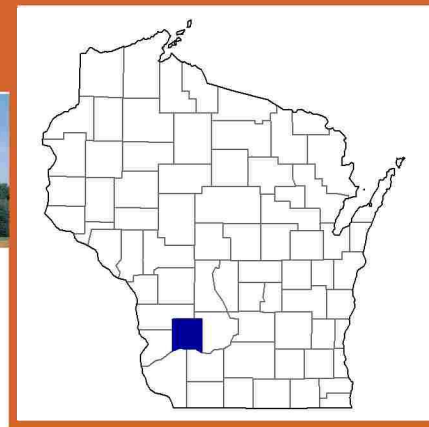
