ALASKA: There were 7.0 days suitable for fieldwork last week. Temperatures for the first two weeks of June were above normal for most of the major growing areas. Precipitation so far in June was slightly below normal for most growing areas. Rate of crop growth was 65% moderate, 35% rapid.

TANANA VALLEY: An average of 7.0 days was suitable for fieldwork. Rate of crop growth was 50% moderate, 50% rapid. Farm activities for the week included planting potatoes, seeding cover crops, spraying weeds in small grains, pastures and hay. More cattle are being put onto pasture.

MATANUSKA VALLEY: An average of 7.0 days was suitable for fieldwork. Rate of crop growth was 85% moderate, 15% rapid. Farm activities for the week included planting commercial vegetables, fertilizing, weed control, irrigation, preparing for hay harvest. A small number of fields have been cut for hay.
