For Week Ending: July 11, 2021

ALASKA: There were **5.5** days suitable for fieldwork last week. Temperatures so far in July were below normal for most of the major growing areas. Precipitation so far for the month was below normal for most of the major growing areas except for Palmer which was slightly above normal. **Rate of crop growth** was 50% moderate, 50% rapid. **Wind and rain damage to crops** was reported as 100% none.

TANANA VALLEY: An average of **5.0 days was suitable for fieldwork. Rate of crop growth** was 25% moderate, 75% rapid. **Wind and rain damage to crops** was reported as 100% none. **Farm activities** for the week included harvesting hay, spraying summer fallow and some small grain acreage as well as fence lines, fertilizing for second cutting hay.

MATANUSKA VALLEY: An average of 6.0 days was suitable for fieldwork. Rate of crop growth was 85% moderate, 15% rapid. Wind and rain damage to crops was reported as 95% none, 5% light. Farm activities for the week included harvesting hay, weed control, fertilizing hay for second cutting, irrigation, farm maintenance. Peony harvest is underway.
