For Week Ending: August 6, 2023

ALASKA: There were **6.5 days suitable for fieldwork** last week. Tanana Valley temperatures were well above average with dry conditions leading to delayed crop progress and concerns for winter feed supplies. Warm and dry conditions were also present in the Matanuska valley. Kenai had warm conditions while Homer's temperatures were close to normal. Many areas in the Kenai Peninsula received rain later in the week.

TANANA VALLEY: An average of **7.0 days was suitable for fieldwork.** Hot and dry conditions continued, which led to stalled growth in non-irrigated pasture and hay fields. Unplanned supplemental feeding of hay and concern for second cutting hay yield are leading to worries about winter feed supplies. **Crop rate of growth** was 30% slow, 40% moderate, and 30% rapid. **Farm activities** for the week included harvesting grass seed and hay, preparing for grain harvest, and general farm maintenance.

MATANUSKA VALLEY: An average of 6.0 day was suitable for fieldwork. Crop rate of growth was 100% moderate. Farm activities for the week included completing the first cutting of hay and farm maintenance.
