For Week Ending: September 17, 2023

ALASKA: There were 3.1 days suitable for fieldwork last week. Wet weather dominated the state's growing regions again for most of the week. Topsoil and subsoil moisture increased significantly during the week. Temperatures in Fairbanks were slightly above

normal for the month and slightly below normal in Delta Junction. Temperatures in Palmer were below normal and rain was recorded almost every day last week. Both Homer and Kenai had averages weekly temperatures slightly below normal.

TANANA VALLEY: An average of **4.0 days was suitable for fieldwork.** Some mild wind damage was reported. Several fields of second cutting hay were baled. Small grain harvests were nearing completion. Local gardens were still producing as there has not been a hard frost in the region. **Farm activities** for the week included harvesting potatoes, baling straw and fall tillage.

MATANUSKA VALLEY: An average of **2.0 days was suitable for fieldwork.** Several potato fields were harvested. **Farm activities** for the week included field preparation and farm maintenance.
