ALASKA: There were 4.3 **days suitable for fieldwork** for the week ending August 4. Rain continued to slow fieldwork in the **Matanuska Valley**. Several producers made their second cutting of hay last week. Many potato fields bloomed. The grass seed harvest continued in the **Tanana Valley** along with baling grass straw. Other activities in the Tanana Valley included CRP brush management, preparing for grain harvest, and general farm maintenance.
