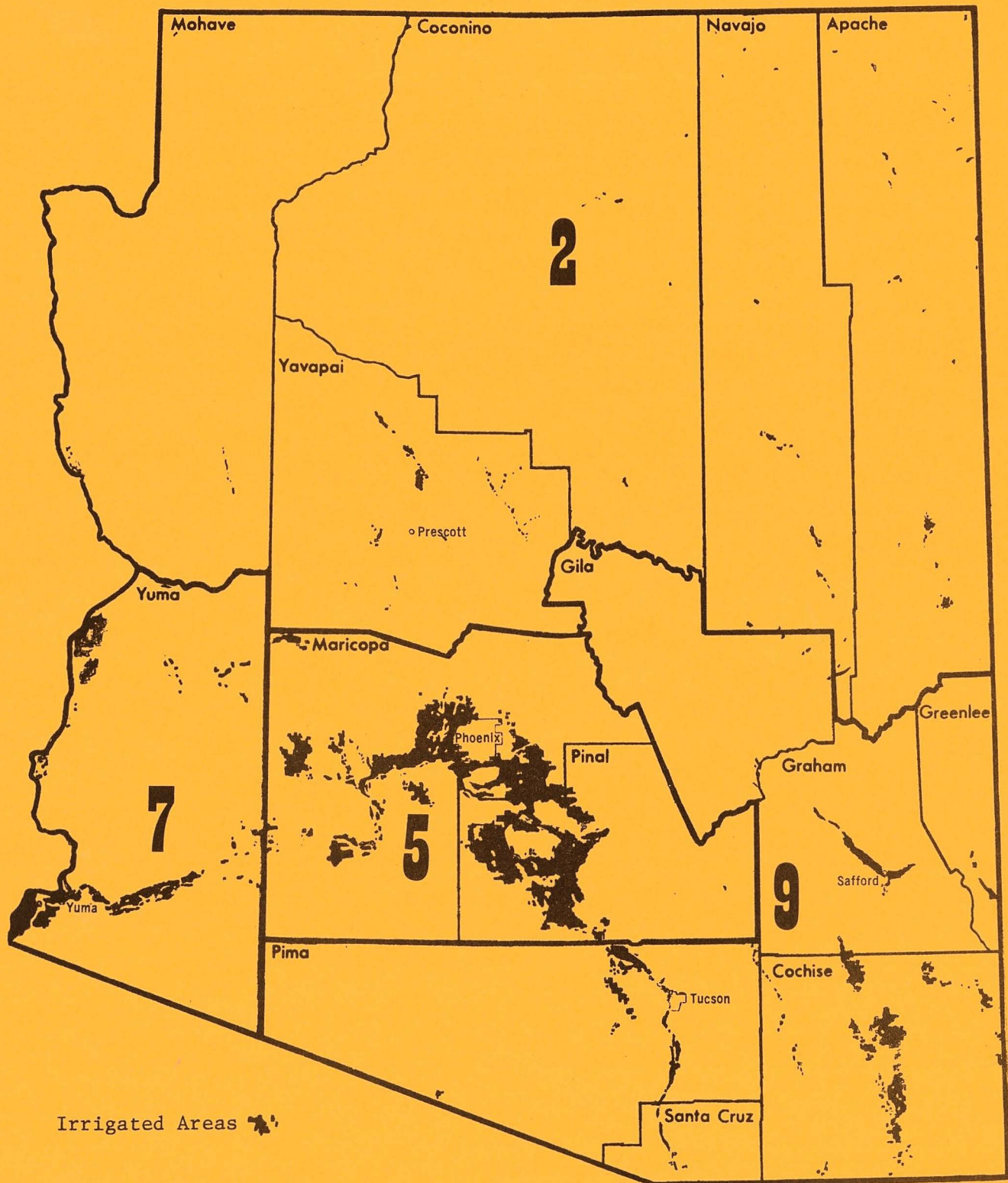

INTRODUCTION

Farming and ranching in Arizona was a billion dollar industry in 1973. Cash receipts from sales of crops and livestock totaled \$988.1 million, and government payments amounted to \$38.2 million. Of the gross 1973 cash receipts for Arizona's agricultural products, crops accounted for about 40 percent and livestock 60 percent. Marketings of cattle and calves for slaughter market generated \$392 million, cotton lint and seed \$138 million, and lettuce \$53 million. Hay, wheat, and sorghum also made significant contributions to the 1973 gross cash receipts.

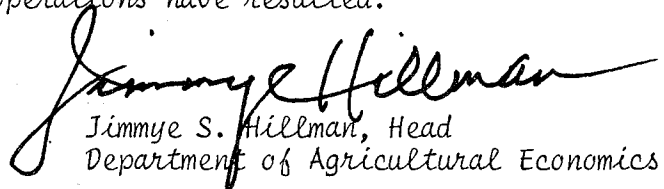
Prices for practically every farm and ranch commodity were significantly higher in 1973. However, farm production expenses were up sharply, the increase from 1972 to 1973 being the largest year-to-year increase on record. Prices paid for items of farm origin--feed, seed, and livestock--were up sharply. Costs for inputs of non-farm origin were higher than in 1972, though gains were more moderate. Prices for fertilizer and petroleum products were relatively stable the first three quarters of 1973 but moved up sharply late in the year.

This, the ninth annual publication of Arizona Agricultural Statistics, includes county estimates of acreage and production for all major crops grown in Arizona. To follow state and county trends, an eight-year series of data is shown. Livestock county estimates were initiated in 1971.

Also available are agricultural statistics for each county in Arizona. These publications show a 3-year county summary of major crop and livestock items, cash receipts from farm marketings and government payments by program.

The primary sources of data for this annual bulletin are voluntary reports from farmers, ranchers, and agri-businessmen. Some crops and livestock items are enumerated but most of the estimates are based on sample surveys.

Collection and publication of these data is a joint effort of the College of Agriculture, The University of Arizona, and the Statistical Reporting Service, United States Department of Agriculture. Through this joint effort, conflicting agricultural statistics are avoided and more efficient operations have resulted.

CASH RECEIPTS FROM AGRICULTURE: Cash receipts from farm marketings represent gross proceeds from sales of agricultural commodities by farmers and ranchers during a calendar year. Data by commodity for 1973 will be available in August 1974.

Statistical data for most commodities published in this bulletin show "Value of Production." Value of production is derived by multiplying production by season average price. This figure in many instances is different from the "Cash Receipts" in the foregoing table. The difference occurs because cash receipts represent gross proceeds from actual sales or marketings, while value of production relates to total production including that part not sold. For instance, cotton grown one year and held for sale the following year will not be included in cash receipts for the year in which it was produced. However, the carryover value will be included as value of production for the year in which it was produced.

The preliminary estimate of cash receipts for 1973 cleared a billion dollars for the first time. At slightly over a billion dollars, the 1973 level is more than \$154 million larger than the 1972 estimate. The increase resulted entirely from higher production and higher prices as estimated government payments were well below 1972. Cash receipts for all crops were up 19 percent, while livestock and livestock products showed a 21 percent increase. Livestock and livestock products accounted for 57 percent of all 1973 cash receipts.

Agricultural Summary - 1973

WEATHER: 1973 was a year of extremes in Arizona's weather conditions. Early in the year, conditions were generally wetter and cooler than usual. In April, the temperatures were still mostly below normal but the rain began to ease off. May saw mostly above-normal temperatures and very little precipitation until the last day of the month. Then heavy rains caused some local flooding. Warm weather began quickly melting a large snowpack in the mountains. The melting of the heavy snowpack and continued showers through May and June made it necessary to release water down the Salt River as all reservoirs were already full. July and August were hot, dry months with only scattered showers. Phoenix recorded no measurable rainfall in August, which broke a record established in 1901. The rest of the year was generally quite dry with temperatures fluctuating above and below normal.

CROPS: The most important thing about 1973 crop production was its value. Some crops were larger than the previous year and some were smaller but cash receipts from the sale of crops in 1973 totaled \$407.4 million. This is 19 percent above the 1972 level. Production of sorghum grain and long staple cotton was below 1972 but the value of production was up for both. Corn and safflower production was down as was the total value of the two crops. Production and value both were up for most other field crops. Commercial vegetables were harvested from fewer acres in 1973 and the total value of vegetable production was down slightly.

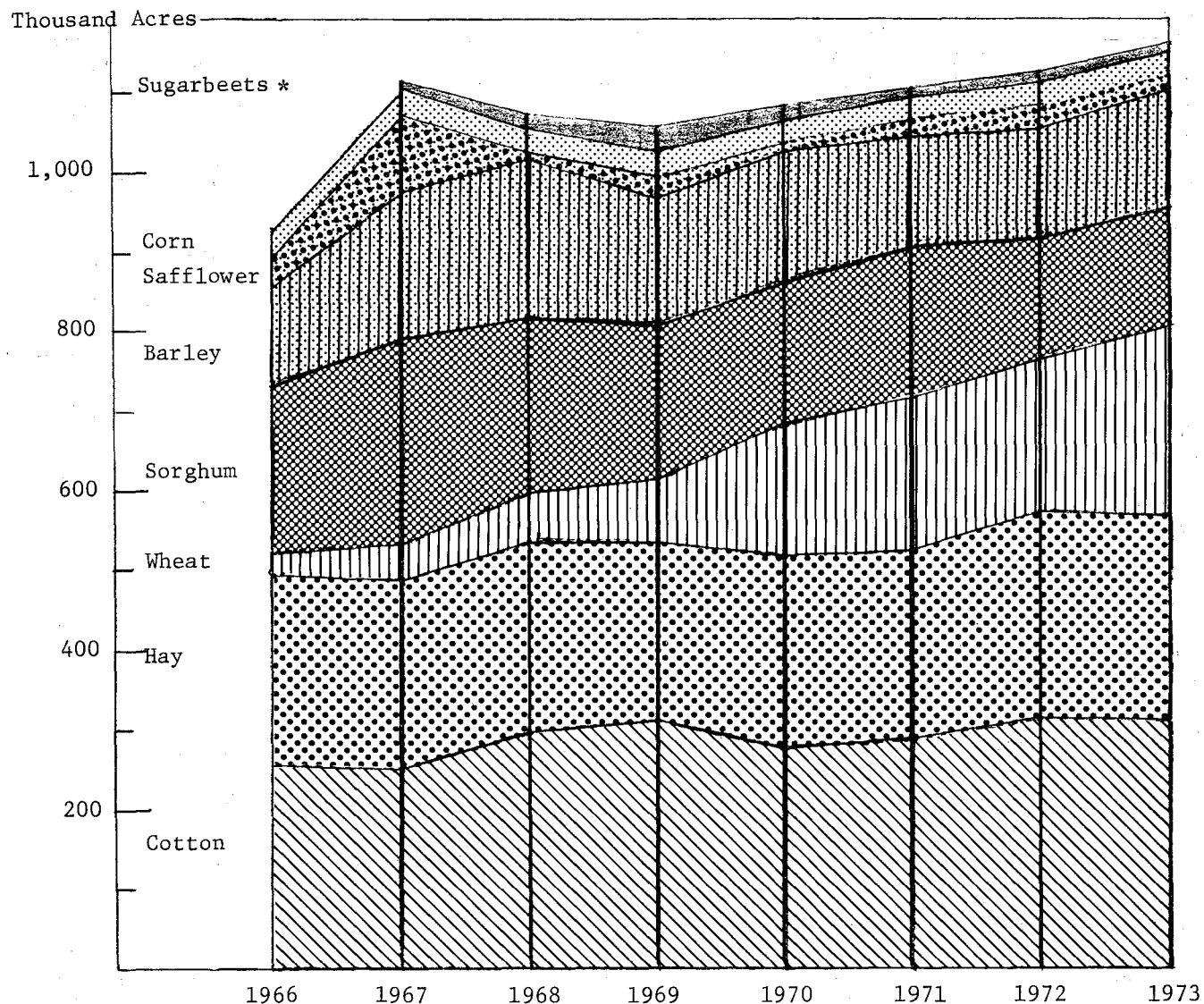
The cool, wet spring caused several crops to develop slower than normal early in the season. However, the soil moisture supply was good and the dry mid-summer allowed crops to catch up later. Later conditions were almost perfect for final development, maturing and crop harvesting.

LIVESTOCK: Cash received from the sale of livestock and livestock products in Arizona totaled \$580.6 million in 1973. This was 21 percent above livestock cash receipts in 1972. Arizona's cattle population declined during the year to a level of 1,390,000 on January 1, 1974. This was 2 percent below the 1973 beginning inventory. At the end of 1973, the population of all sheep and lambs was down 1 percent. Hogs and pigs were at about the same level as the beginning inventory while chicken numbers were up slightly. Weather conditions were generally good for cattlemen at the beginning of the year. The cool, wet, early spring encouraged a plentiful growth of range grasses and kept stock tanks full. Then, in the summer, the rains quit and very hot weather became the general situation. The rest of the year was generally dry and range conditions deteriorated as a result.

Field Crops

ARIZONA CROP ACREAGES



Most of Arizona's cropland is planted to crops shown in this chart. Since 1966, there has been significant variation in individual crop acreages, but the total of all crops has remained relatively stable. An exception to this general statement is the increase from 1966 to 1967. Following plowup of the 1966 cotton crop, much of that acreage was seeded to small grains. This small grain acreage was harvested in the early summer of 1967, and after harvest, much of this acreage was planted to sorghum, which was also harvested in 1967.

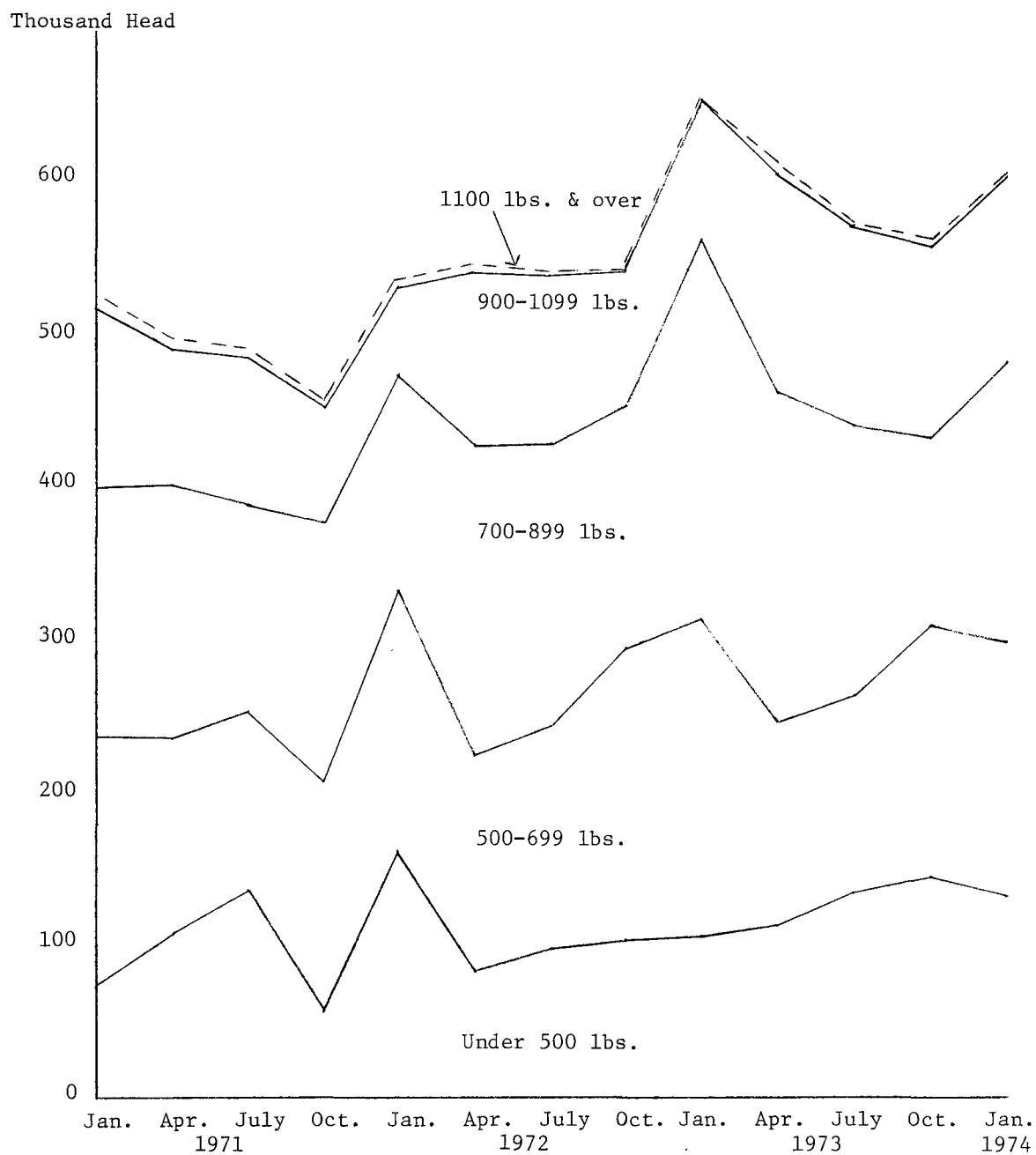

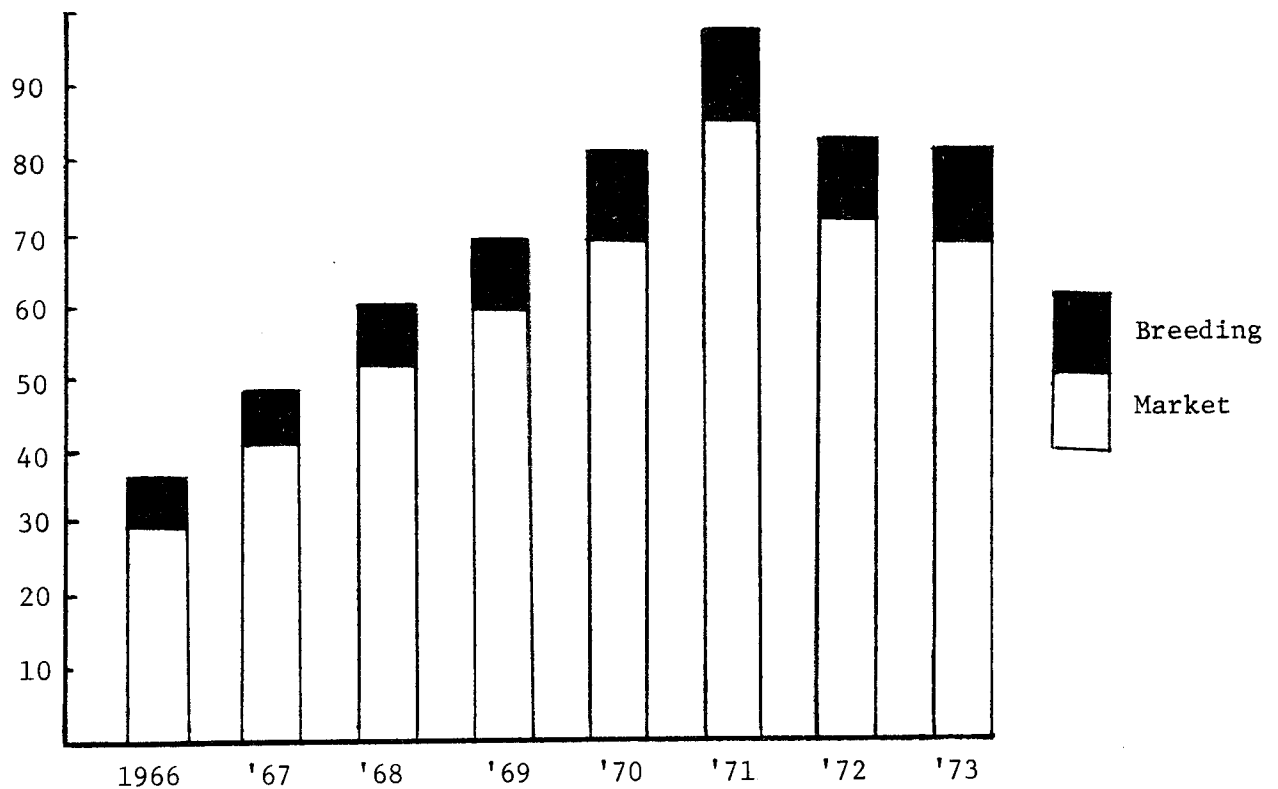

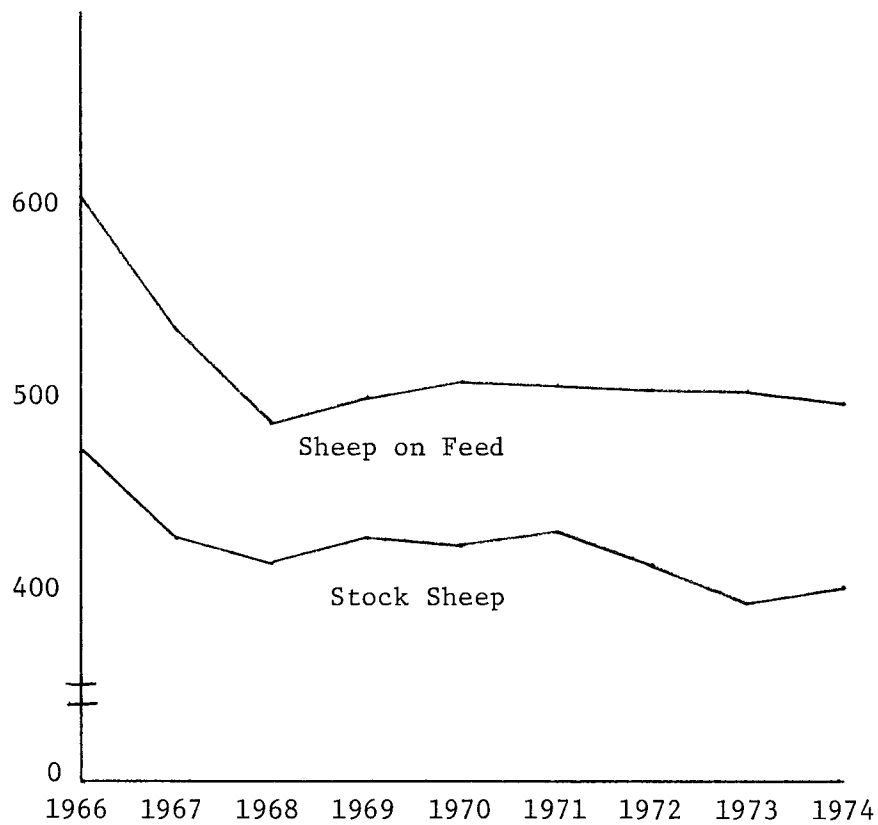

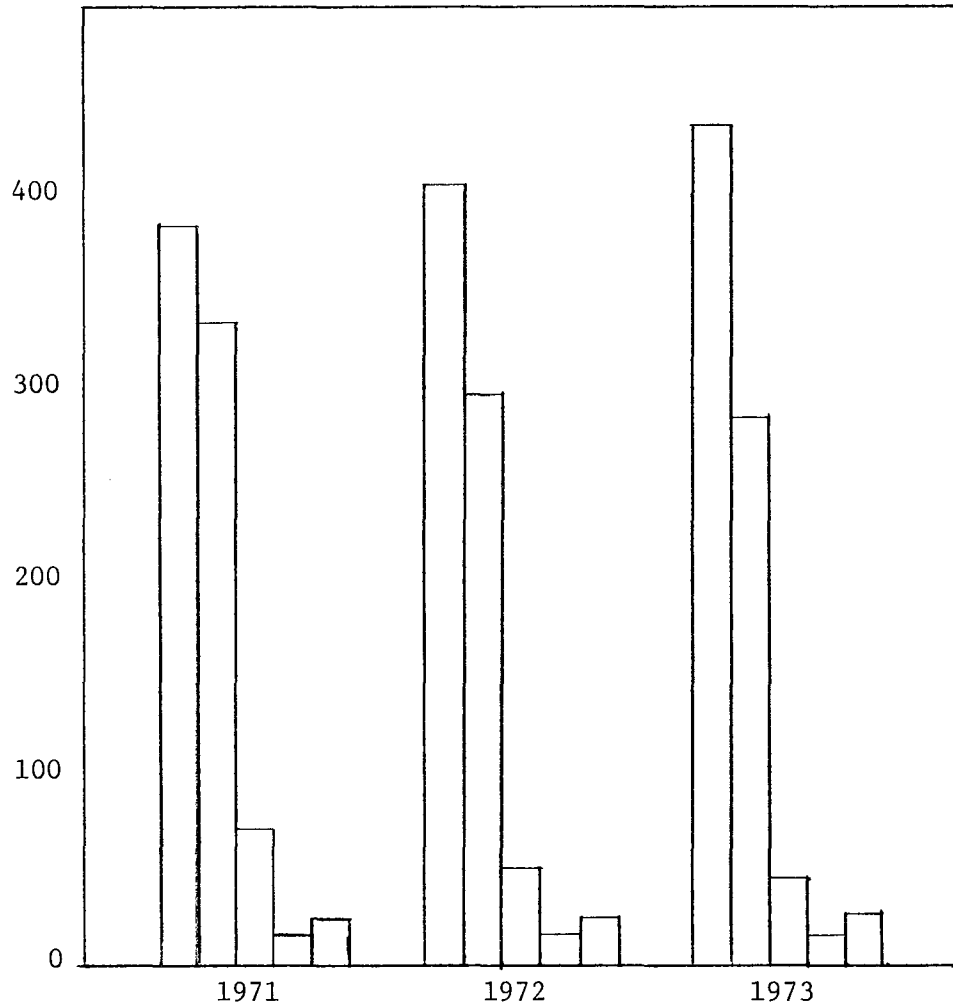

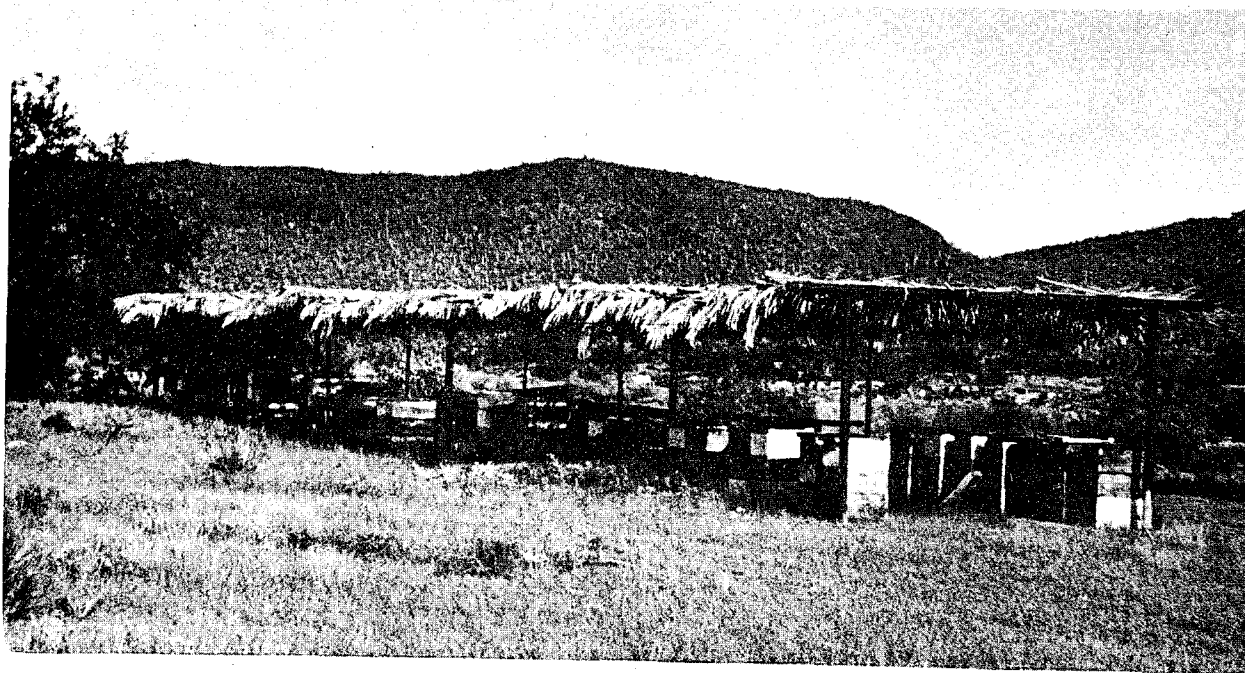

WATER SUPPLY: Adequate water supplies are predicted for all areas of Arizona served by reservoir storage. With streamflow forecasts ranging from one-quarter to one-half of average, some shortages are likely in areas depending on direct diversions.

SNOW COVER: Snow cover varies from 50% of average on the Gila to slightly above average on the Verde. Percentage-wise, the heaviest snow occurs along the Mogollon Rim between Heber and Mormon Lake. In the White Mountains above 9,000 feet the snow cover is near normal, but is much below normal at the lower levels.

PRECIPITATION: With February precipitation 25 to 50% of normal, the accumulated winter precipitation is now significantly below average. The month was characterized by many weak storm systems with very light and widely scattered snowfall.

SOIL MOISTURE: Surface soils below the snow line are wet, but the extreme deficiency still exists in the subsoil. Much more than normal precipitation will be necessary to produce normal runoff.

RESERVOIR STORAGE: All major reservoir systems in central Arizona contain above average storage. Water levels, however, are declining as use exceeds inflow. With no concern to spilling water this year, management problems now focus on how to obtain maximum power generation during the peak demand season and on conserving water.
