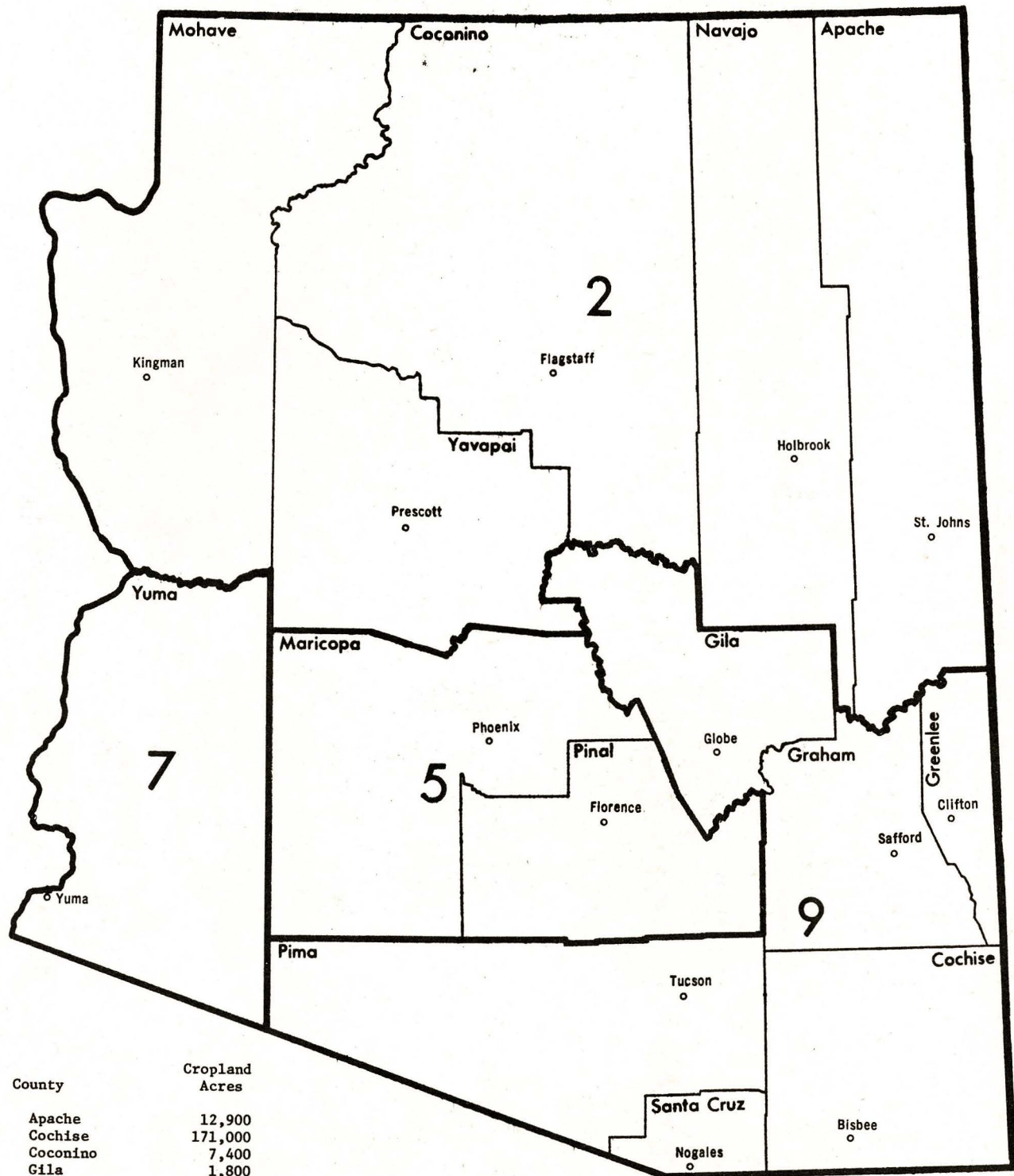

INTRODUCTION

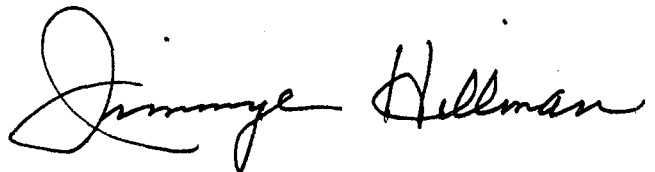
Farming and ranching in Arizona was again a billion dollar industry in 1974. Cash receipts from sales of Arizona's farm and ranch products grossed \$1.2 billion in 1974, up 12 percent from 1973. However, a surge in production expenses more than offset the gain in gross income. State estimates of farm production expenses are not available and are not a function of this Statistical Report. Nationally, prices paid for production items--interest, taxes and wage rates--jumped 15 percent from 1973. The feed bill rose 17 percent; fertilizer prices averaged some 70 percent above a year earlier. Fuel prices zoomed upward and seed prices, reflecting tight supplies, were up one-third. The only major input showing a drop in price was feeder livestock, which averaged about 25 percent lower.

Of the \$1.2 billion generated by Arizona's farms and ranches in 1974, crops accounted for 49 percent compared with 39 percent in 1973. Livestock and livestock products accounted for 51 percent of the 1974 total and 61 percent of the 1973 gross.

Arizona's farms and ranches not only support those engaged in production of crops and livestock but many others, who provide the input items necessary to produce and distribute the State's agricultural output. Vendors of items necessary for production need agricultural statistics in order to provide supplies, services and finance. Those engaged in distribution follow trends in producing areas for various crops. Forward planning makes it possible for them to take care of the production.

This tenth annual publication of Arizona Agricultural Statistics presents unbiased county estimates of acreage and production for all major crops grown in Arizona. County estimates of livestock numbers--January 1, 1971 to January 1, 1975--are also included. Collection and publication of these data is a joint effort of the College of Agriculture, The University of Arizona, and the Statistical Reporting Service, United States Department of Agriculture. Voluntary reporters--farmers, ranchers and agri-businessmen--supply the basic data used for this bulletin. Some crop and livestock items are enumerated; however, most estimates are based on sample surveys. Each reporter can take pride in the estimates because he helps make them. This is an essential public service and helps many people.

In October 1974, the College of Agriculture, The University of Arizona, and the Arizona Crop and Livestock Reporting Service published the Cropland Atlas of Arizona. That bulletin of 68 pages provides an irrigated land resource inventory and illustrates the location, size and shape of agricultural fields for the entire State as they appear from high altitudes. CASH RECEIPTS FROM AGRICULTURE: Cash receipts from farm marketings represent gross proceeds from sales of agricultural commodities by farmers and ranchers during a calendar year. Data by commodity for 1974 will be available in August 1975 after final estimates of prices and quantity sold by months are available. The totals shown for 1974 are preliminary estimates based primarily on production and monthly prices without current data on monthly sales.

Statistical data for most commodities published in this bulletin show "Value of Production." Value of production is derived by multiplying production by season average price. This figure in many instances is different from the "Cash Receipts" in the foregoing table. The difference occurs because cash receipts represent gross proceeds from actual sales or marketings, while value of production relates to total production including that part not sold. For instance, cotton grown one year and held for sale the following year will not be included in cash receipts for the year in which it was produced. However, the carryover value will be included as value of production for the year in which it was produced.

The preliminary estimate of cash receipts from 1974 sales of agricultural products is over \$1.2 billion. This is 12 percent more than 1973. Cash receipts from crops were 42 percent above 1973 while livestock cash receipts were down 6 percent. Most of the increase in crop cash receipts was a result of higher production rather than higher prices received by producers. Livestock cash receipts accounted for 51 percent of all commodity cash receipts compared to an average of 59 percent for the previous 3 years.

Agricultural Summary - 1974

WEATHER: Precipitation was generally short in the State during 1974. Some showers and snowfall were recorded early in January but after that, most areas received below normal rainfall until late in the year. Other than dry, much of the spring weather was also typified by very low humidity, warm and gusty. March saw some near record high temperatures as did June. The record heat in June coupled with winds and extremely low humidity readings contributed to several forest fires which were ignited by lightning strikes. The summer monsoon arrived in late July and continued through August and early September, but many areas still remained below normal in precipitation. Scattered showers were recorded throughout the rest of the year bringing some areas up to normal annual precipitation, but much of the west and south remained drier than normal.

CROPS: Preliminary estimates of cash receipts for all crops show 1974 crop sales grossed \$603.5 million--42 percent above the 1973 level. However, it was also a year of skyrocketing production costs. The cash receipts increase is not, therefore, an indication of the change in realized net farm income from crops. Cotton lint led the way in increasing cash receipts from the sale of crops. Cotton sales in 1974, including sales of part of the 1973 crop, accounted for over one-third of all crop cash receipts and were 81 percent above the 1973 level. Production of cotton in 1974 was at the second largest level on record. The 1974 wheat crop was a record sized crop and cash receipts from wheat sales during the year were 32 percent above 1973. Grain sorghum cash receipts were estimated to exceed the 1973 level by 38 percent, while hay cash receipts were up 40 percent.

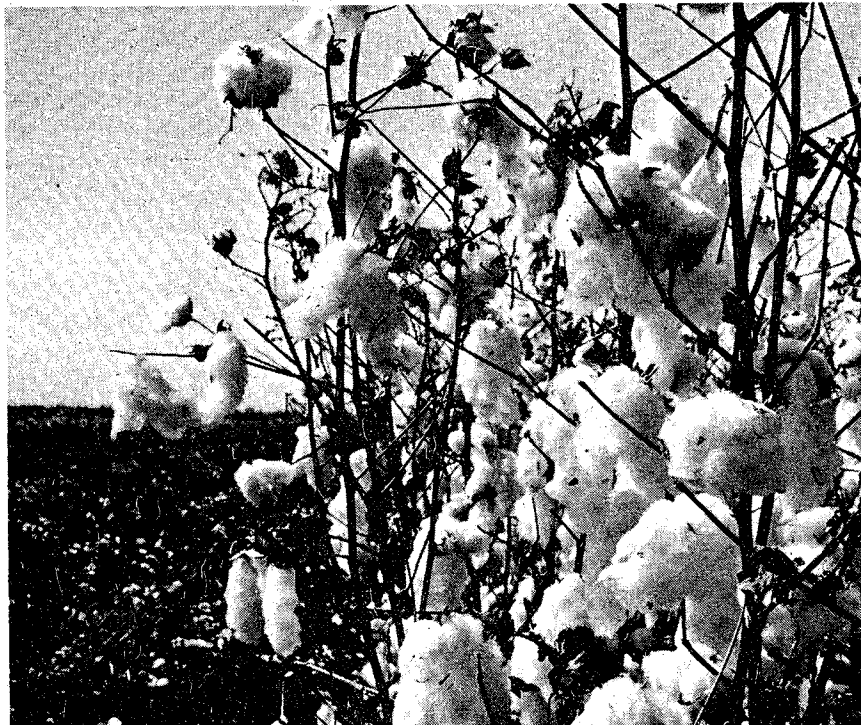
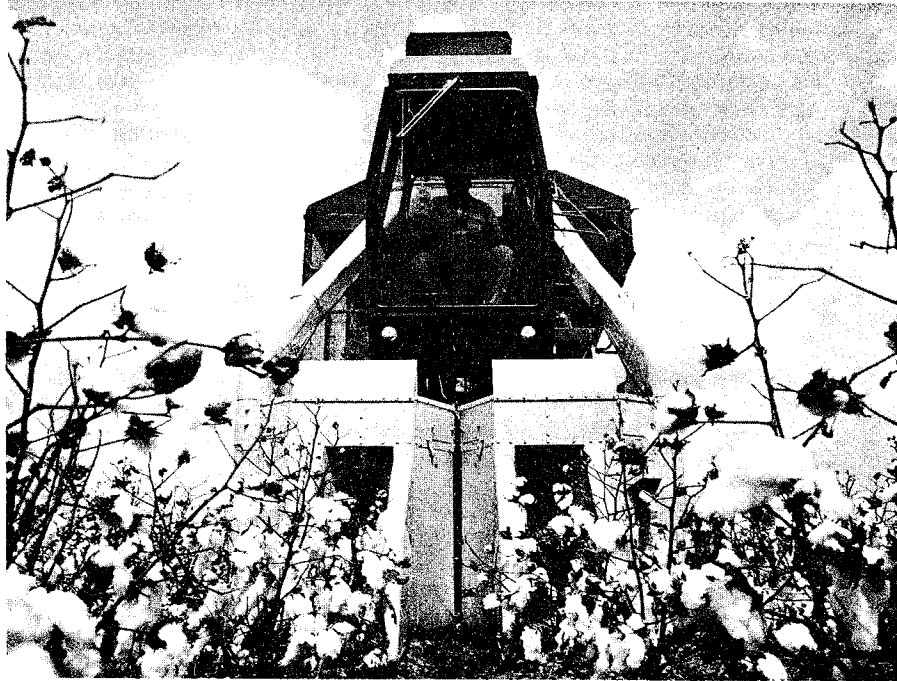
With the exception of some rain damage to windrowed hay, weather conditions were not much of a problem during 1974 despite the record-breaking heat wave in June.

LIVESTOCK: It was a year of lower prices and larger problems than 1973. From early spring until late fall, range conditions were very dry. Supplemental feeding and water hauling were necessary much of that time. Feed prices climbed as cattle prices dropped. Cattle numbers declined during the year to 1,170,000 head on January 1, 1975, the lowest level since 1968. Cattle in feedlots at the beginning of the year numbered 609,000 head but by January 1, 1975 totaled only 319,000 head.

Cash receipts from all livestock and livestock products are estimated at \$628.8 million in 1974. This is 6 percent below 1973. Cash receipts from cattle and calves declined 8 percent from 1973 while hogs were down 4 percent. Sheep and lambs sales values were up 8 percent and dairy products cash receipts increased 12 percent. Cash receipts from poultry and eggs were down 14 percent from the 1973 level.

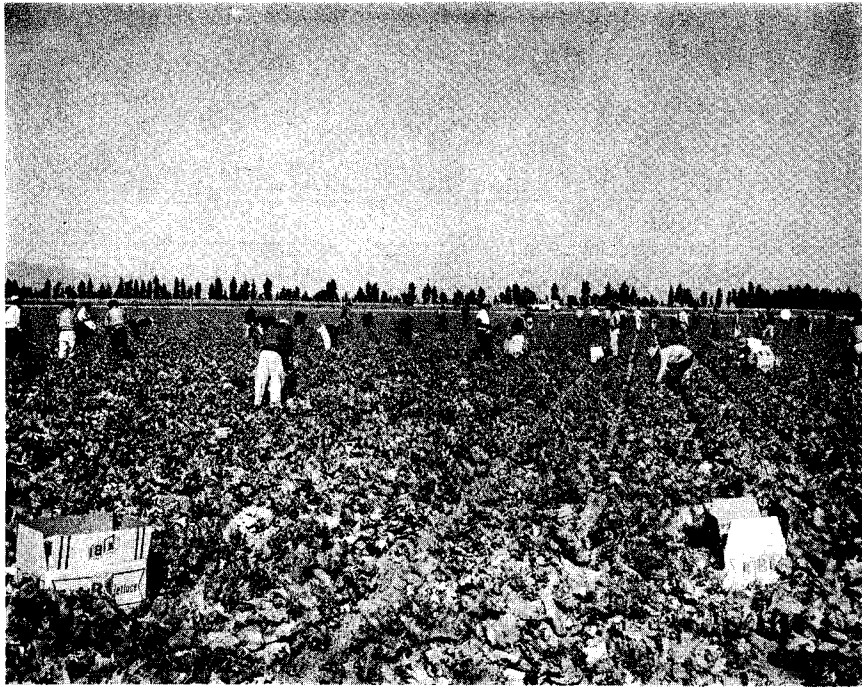

WATER SUPPLY: Water supplies will be adequate in all areas of the state this year, but carry-over supplies will be low for next year. February runoff was good on the Salt and Gila Rivers, but low flows continued on the Verde.

SNOW COVER: The mid-February storm was heavier than previously thought, with increases of three to four inches of water content occurring in parts of the White Mountains. The eastern part of the Verde Watershed also received good snowfall, but in the west it was almost non-existent. Snow cover now varies from ninety percent of average on the Verde to 118 percent on the Salt and Little Colorado Watersheds.

PRECIPITATION: February precipitation was quite variable, with stations only a few miles apart often receiving greatly different amounts. The higher elevations generally received much more than their usual comparative amounts. Total accumulated precipitation since November 1 is still much below normal at most mountain sites.

SOIL MOISTURE: Soil moisture is very good in all areas except the western Verde. Runoff yields could be moderate if March precipitation is above average.

RESERVOIR STORAGE: Reservoir storage is slightly below average for this date, but much below that in storage a year ago. Salt River project reservoirs are half full and contain 87 percent of the 1958-72 15-year average. San Carlos Reservoir is only one-quarter full, but this is slightly above average.
