## CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION WEEK ENDING AUGUST 15, 2021

**AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY:** By the end of the week, 37 percent of the cotton crop has reached the bolls opening stage compared to 44 percent last year, according to the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA. Cotton conditions were rated mostly good to excellent. Alfalfa conditions were rated mostly excellent to fair depending on location last week, with harvesting taking place on over three-quarters of the alfalfa acreage across the state. For the entire state, pasture and range conditions were rated mostly very poor to fair. Exceptional drought covers only 5.88 percent of the state compared to 6.05 percent last week, according to the United States Drought Monitor, and continues to affect pasture and range conditions. In the north central and northwestern part of the state, monsoon rains have helped improve forage growth and soil moisture conditions. Stock tanks have been filling again, but supplemental feed is still necessary due to the timing of the rain in some northwestern areas. In the south central and southeastern part of the state, heavy monsoon rains have helped improve soil and drought conditions.
