COTTON GINNINGS – 2024 CROP

ARIZONA

Arizona gins processed 266,450 running bales (274,650 480-pound bales) of **all cotton** from the 2024 crop, compared with 210,250 running bales (293,300 480-pound bales) from the 2023 crop, according to the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA. Of the 266,450 running bales ginned, 237,050 running bales (244,950 480-pound bales) were **upland cotton**, and 29,400 running bales (29,700 480-pound bales) were **Pima cotton**.

NEW MEXICO

New Mexico gins processed 44,200 running bales (44,600 480-pound bales) of **all cotton** from the 2024 crop, compared with 45,050 running bales (45,600 480-pound bales) from the 2023 crop, according to the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA. Of the 44,200 running bales ginned, 22,050 running bales (22,200 480-pound bales) were **upland cotton**, and 22,150 running bales (22,400 480-pound bales) were **Pima cotton**.

UNITED STATES

United States running bales of **all cotton** ginned from harvest in 2024 totaled 14.07 million running bales (14.38 million 480-pound bales), compared with 11.76 million running bales (12.04 million 480-pound bales) from the same period in 2023. Of that, 13.62 million running bales (13.91 million 480-pound bales) were **upland cotton** and 458,400 running bales (468,750 480-pound bales) were **Pima cotton**.

There were 446 active cotton gins during the 2024 season, down from the 463 gins that operated in 2023. Fifty-eight percent of the gins processed more than 20,000 running bales compared with 46 percent the previous season.
