Week Ending: March 28, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 2.7 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, March 28, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 3 percent short, 35 percent adequate, and 62 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 5 percent short, 49 percent adequate, and 45 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 37.9 degrees Fahrenheit at Calico Rock to 53.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Rowher. Highs ranged from 63.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 77.7 degrees Fahrenheit at Crossett. Moderate to heavy precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the east central part of the State with an average of 3.43 inches.
