Week Ending: April 4, 2021

Released: April 5, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 3.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, April 4, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 5 percent short, 42 percent adequate, and 53 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 5 percent short, 58 percent adequate, and 36 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 31.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Mammoth Spring to 45.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Des Arc. Highs ranged from 58.9 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 68.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Portland. Light precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the southeast part of the State with an average of 0.96 inch.
