Week Ending: April 11, 2021

Released: April 12, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 4.4 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, April 11, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 5 percent short, 58 percent adequate, and 37 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 6 percent short, 66 percent adequate, and 27 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 41.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Cabot to 58.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Eudora. Highs ranged from 67.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 78.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Eudora. Light to moderate precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the east central part of the State with an average of 1.29 inches.
