Week Ending: June 27, 2021

Released: June 28, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, June 27, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 7 percent very short, 35 percent short, 53 percent adequate, and 5 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 26 percent short, 64 percent adequate, and 7 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 61.5 degrees Fahrenheit at Cabot to 71.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Portland. Highs ranged from 78.9 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 92.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Cabot. Light to moderate precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the northwest part of the State with an average of 1.25 inches.
