Week Ending: July 11, 2021

Released: July 12, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 6.3 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, July 11, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 8 percent very short, 39 percent short, 49 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 6 percent very short, 38 percent short, 53 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 64.9 degrees Fahrenheit at Evening Shade to 73.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Des Arc. Highs ranged from 81.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 92.7 degrees Fahrenheit at Crossett, Des Arc and Morrilton. Light to moderate precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the southwest part of the State with an average of 1.68 inches.
