**Released: July 19, 2021**

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 5.9 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, July 18, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 5 percent very short, 30 percent short, 55 percent adequate, and 10 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 31 percent short, 56 percent adequate, and 9 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 64.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 72.1 degrees Fahrenheit at Rohwer and Stuttgart. Highs ranged from 77.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 92.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Crossett. Moderate to heavy precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the northwest part of the State with an average of 2.55 inches.
