Week Ending: August 1, 2021

Released: August 2, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 6.7 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, August 1, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 7 percent very short, 35 percent short, 53 percent adequate, and 5 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 6 percent very short, 35 percent short, 55 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 69.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Mena to 77.2 degrees Fahrenheit at Crossett. Highs ranged from 86.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 99.2 degrees Fahrenheit at Crossett. Light to moderate precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the southeast part of the State with an average of 1.51 inches.
