Week Ending: August 8, 2021

Released: August 9, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 6.9 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, August 8, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 12 percent very short, 56 percent short, 29 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 10 percent very short, 54 percent short, 34 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 62.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Mammoth Spring to 70.1 degrees Fahrenheit at Portland. Highs ranged from 79.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 91.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Cabot. Light precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the south central part of the State with an average of 0.98 inch.
