# Arkansas Crop Progress and Condition

**Released: September 7, 2021**

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, September 5, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 19 percent very short, 43 percent short, 38 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 19 percent very short, 40 percent short, 40 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 64.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Mammoth Spring to 72.7 degrees Fahrenheit at Ashdown. Highs ranged from 85.1 degrees Fahrenheit at Corning to 96.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Waldron. Light precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the northwest part of the State with an average of 1.34 inches.
