## Arkansas Crop Progress and Condition

**Released: September 13, 2021**

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 6.9 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, September 12, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 24 percent very short, 45 percent short, 29 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 24 percent very short, 37 percent short, 31 percent adequate, and 8 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 54.7 degrees Fahrenheit at Gilbert to 65.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Winslow. Highs ranged from 81.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 90.7 degrees Fahrenheit at Nashville. Insignificant precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the central, northeast and the southwest part of the State with an average of 0.16 inch.
