Week Ending: September 26, 2021

Released: September 27, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 5.8 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, September 26, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 15 percent very short, 43 percent short, 39 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 17 percent very short, 44 percent short, 37 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 50.1 degrees Fahrenheit at Gilbert to 61.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Hot Springs. Highs ranged from 73.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 85.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Crossett. Light precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the southeast part of the State with an average of 1.38 inches.
