Week Ending: October 31, 2021

Released: November 1, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 4.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, October 31, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 21 percent short, 60 percent adequate, and 15 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 5 percent very short, 25 percent short, 56 percent adequate, and 14 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 42.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 56.5 degrees Fahrenheit at Pine Bluff. Highs ranged from 56.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 77.2 degrees Fahrenheit at De Queen. Light to moderate precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the northwest part of the State with an average of 1.78 inches.
