Week Ending: November 21, 2021

Released: November 22, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 6.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, November 21, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 15 percent short, 79 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 22 percent short, 72 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 31.2 degrees Fahrenheit at Gilbert to 45.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Winslow. Highs ranged from 58.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Corning to 70.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Magnolia. Light precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the northeast part of the State with an average of 0.73 inch.
