According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 5.2 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, June 5, 2022**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 12 percent short, 63 percent adequate, and 24 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 10 percent short, 64 percent adequate, and 24 percent surplus.
