According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 5.2 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, August 21, 2022**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 20 percent short, 69 percent adequate, and 7 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 6 percent very short, 31 percent short, 53 percent adequate, and 10 percent surplus.
