Broiler-Type Eggs Set Up 2 Percent from Last Year

Arkansas hatcheries set 23.7 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending October 8, 2022, up 2 percent from the comparable week in 2021 but down 6 percent from the previous week.

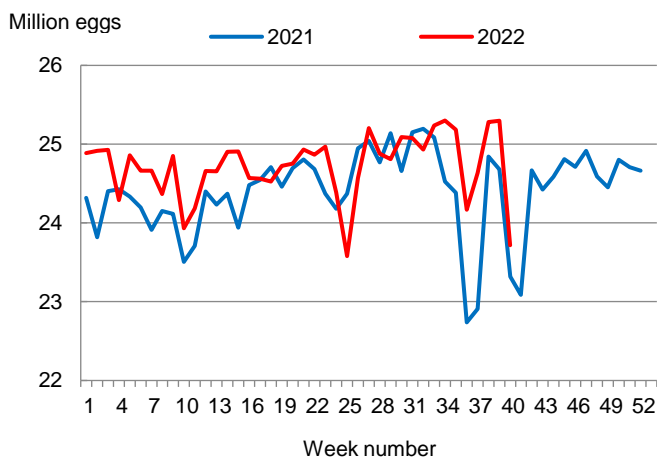
Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 237 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 8, 2022, up 3 percent from a year ago.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed Up 8 Percent

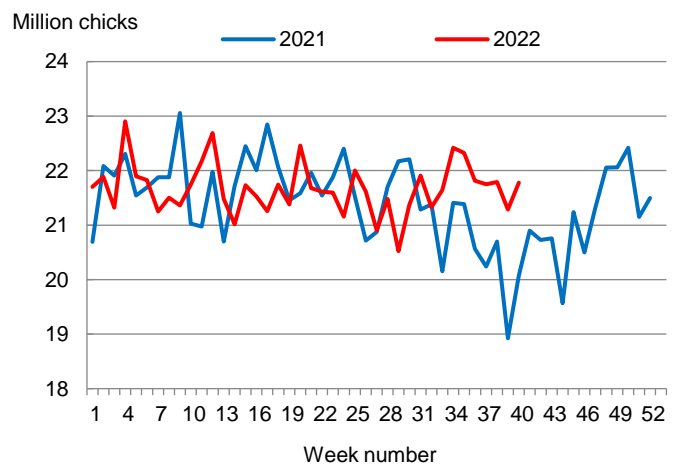
Arkansas broiler-type chicks placed for meat production were 21.8 million chicks during the week ending October 8, 2022, up 8 percent from the comparable week in 2021 and up 2 percent from the previous week.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 187 million chicks for meat production during the week ending October 8, 2022, up 5 percent from a year ago.
