#### **Hog Inventory Down 9 Percent**

Arkansas inventory of all hogs and pigs on December 1, 2023, totaled 134,000 head, was down 9 percent from December 1, 2022; breeding hog inventory, at 43,000 head, was down 7 percent from previous year; and market hog inventory, at 91,000 head, was down 10 percent from the previous year. For the December 2022 - November 2023 period, the pig crop totaled 941,000 head, up 6 percent from the same time period the previous year. Sows farrowing during the period totaled 76,000 head, down 4 percent from the previous year. The average number of pigs saved per litter for December 2022 - November 2023 was 12.38 head, up 10 percent from last year.

**United States** inventory of all hogs and pigs on December 1, 2023 was 75.0 million head. This was up slightly from December 1, 2022, but down slightly from September 1, 2023. Breeding inventory, at 6.00 million head, was down 3 percent from last year, and down 3 percent from the previous quarter. Market hog inventory, at 69.0 million head, was up slightly from last year, but down slightly from last quarter.


