## CALIFORNIA EGG PRODUCTION

California's egg production during June totaled 266 million, down 19 million from May's production and down 52 million from June 2022. The all layers during the month totaled 11.4 million, down 3 percent from last month, and down 16 percent from June 2022. Eggs per 100 layers during the month were 2,344, compared to 2,434 a month earlier, and 2,366 in June 2022.

## U.S. JUNE EGG PRODUCTION

United States egg production totaled 9.08 billion during June 2023, up 4 percent from last year. Production included 7.78 billion table eggs, and 1.30 billion hatching eggs, of which 1.20 billion were broiler-type and 95.8 million were egg-type. The total number of layers during June 2023 averaged 387 million, up 5 percent from last year. June egg production per 100 layers was 2.348 eggs, down 1 percent from June 2022.

Total layers in the United States on July 1, 2023 totaled 386 million, up 5 percent from last year. The 386 million layers consisted of 317 million layers producing table or market type eggs, 65.0 million layers producing broiler-type hatching eggs, and 3.69 million layers producing egg-type hatching eggs. Rate of lay per day on July 1, 2023, averaged 78.5 eggs per 100 layers, down 1 percent from July 1, 2022.

## U.S. EGG-TYPE CHICKS HATCHED

Egg-type chicks hatched during June 2023 totaled 57.4 million, up 1 percent from June 2022. Eggs in incubators totaled 49.1 million on July 1, 2023, up 8 percent from a year ago.

Domestic placements of egg-type pullet chicks for future hatchery supply flocks by leading breeders totaled 199 thousand during June 2023, down 9 percent from June 2022.

## U.S. BROILER-TYPE CHICKS HATCHED

Broiler-type chicks hatched during June 2023 totaled 830 million, down 1 percent from June 2022. Eggs in incubators totaled 726 billion on July 1, 2023, up slightly from a year ago.

Leading breeders placed 8.38 million broiler-type pullet chicks for future domestic hatchery supply flocks during June 2023, down 4 percent from June 2022.

## U.S. TURKEY HATCHERY PRODUCTION

Turkey eggs in incubators on July 1, 2023, in the United States totaled 27.2 million, up 1 percent from July 1, 2022. Eggs in incubators were down 1 percent from the June 1, 2023, total of 27.5 million eggs.

Turkey poults hatched during June 2023, in the United States totaled 24.0 million, up 4 percent from June 2022. Poults hatched were up 2 percent from the May 2023 total of 23.6 million poults.

The 22.9 million net poults placed during June 2023 in the United States were up 4 percent from the number placed during the same month a year earlier. Net placements were up 3 percent from the May 2023 total of 22.3 million.
