United States Commercial Slaughter

Commercial red meat production for the United States totaled 4.68 billion pounds in November 2023, down 2 percent from the 4.79 billion pounds produced in November 2022.

Beef production, at 2.28 billion pounds, was 6 percent below the previous year. Cattle slaughter totaled 2.73 million head, down 6 percent from November 2022.

Veal production totaled 4.30 million pounds, 6 percent below November a year ago. Calf slaughter totaled 24,200 head, down 22 percent from November 2022.

Pork production totaled 2.39 billion pounds, up 2 percent from the previous year. Hog slaughter totaled 11.1 million head, up 2 percent from November 2022.

Lamb and mutton production, at 11.2 million pounds, was up 1 percent from November 2022. Sheep slaughter totaled 189,600 head, 5 percent above last year.

Pacific Region Commercial Slaughter

California's production of red meat during November 2023 totaled 104 million pounds (dressed weight), 29 percent below than November 2022. This figure includes slaughter in Federally-inspected and state-inspected plants, but excludes farm slaughter. In November 2023, the average live weight of cattle slaughtered in California was 1,354 pounds, sheep and lambs averaged 143 pounds, and hogs averaged 227 pounds. In Hawaii, 800,000 pounds of red meat were produced in November 2023, and 100,000 pounds of red meat were produced in Nevada.
