Weighted average price represents the average roadside price paid to growers and packinghouses for fresh Freestone peaches used for freezing or drying. Freezers grading Freestone peaches reported approximately 3 percent as offgrade. Dry yards do not grade Freestone peaches, so there is not an offgrade percentage.
