POTATO STOCKS – APRIL 1, 2025

NOTE: This will be the last issue of the state-level *Potato Stocks* report made by the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA. You can access the National *Potato Stocks* report, which includes state-level data, from www.nass.usda.gov/publications.

COLORADO HIGHLIGHTS

Potato stocks in Colorado on April 1, 2025, totaled 6.70 million hundredweight, down 1 percent from the 6.80 million hundredweight stored last year. The indicated season to date disappearance totaled 15.05 million hundredweight. Potatoes in storage accounted for 31 percent of the 2024 production, compared with 32 percent a year earlier.

UNITED STATES HIGHLIGHTS

Potatoes held in storage on April 1, 2025 totaled 131 million cwt, down 6 percent from April 1, 2024. Potatoes in storage accounted for 31 percent of the 2024 production, the same as a year earlier. The indicated season to date disappearance, at 290 million cwt, was down 4 percent from the same period last year. Season to date shrink and loss, at 20.9 million cwt, was down 2 percent from the same time last year. Processors in the 8 States used 147 million cwt of potatoes for the season, down 5 percent from April 2024.
