According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, April 27, 2025. Topsoil moisture supplies were 7 percent very short, 51 percent short, 41 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 29 percent very short, 32 percent short, 37 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 6 percent very short, 25 percent short, 56 percent adequate, and 13 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 7 percent very short, 33 percent short, 57 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus.
