FLORIDA: The forecast of avocados for certified shipments is maintained at 950,000 bushels. This is four percent more than last season and 28 percent more than the 1995-96 season.

Through December, shipments total 923,200 bushels, the most in several seasons. Advanced maturity and good demand all season led to this fast harvest. Winter varieties are

light set with only an indicated 26,800 bushels remaining to be shipped.

CALIFORNIA: Shipments through December 27 total 591,000 bushel equivalents, near the same as last season to date. Early season projections are for near the same size crop as last season.
