FLORIDA: The forecast of avocados for certified shipments is continued at 950,000 bushels. This is slightly more than the 918,000 bushels shipped last season. The shipping season is almost over.

Shipments in January were very light as winter varieties were nearly depleted because of advanced maturity this season.

Trees are in excellent condition from the abundent rains this winter and a heavy bloom is expected.

**CALIFORNIA**: Shipments through January are near the same level as last season even with adverse weather conditions. Frequent rains have interrupted harvest but quality is reported good. Some droppage from windy weather is also occurring. Projections are for the crop size to be near the same as last season.
