**FLORIDA:** The forecast of avocados for certified shipments is continued at 950,000 bushels. This is four percent more than the previous season shipments of 918,000 bushels. It is 15 percent less than the 1991-92 season's 1,111,000 bushel shipments.

Bearing acreage is estimated at 5,700 acres, the same as last season. Trees planted after 1992 are beginning to bear limited amounts of fruit.

Shipments through August total 425,900 bushels, the most to that time in many seasons. Maturity levels of the summer varieties are 2-3 weeks ahead of normal with large fruit sizes.

**CALIFORNIA:** Shipments through August are 5,922,000 bushel equivalents. Two months remain in the shipping season with total shipments estimated slightly more than the previous season.
