FLORIDA: The forecast of avocados for certified shipments is maintained at 950,000 bushels. If realized, this will be slightly more than the 918,000 bushels shipped last season and the largest crop since the 1991-92 season.

Through September, almost 600,000 bushels have been shipped, the result of a heavy crop on the summer varieties.

Winter varieties are reported to have lighter fruit set than last season.

CALIFORNIA: With one month remaining in the 1996-97 season, shipments total 6,313,000 bushel equivalents as reported by the California Avocado Commission. Expected total shipments for the season are near last season's 6,535,000 bushels.
