**FLORIDA**: The forecast of avocados for certified shipments is continued at 900,000 bushels. This is slightly less than was shipped the last two seasons.

Shipments to date at 876,700 bushels are near two seasons ago when a total of 918,000 bushels were shipped. Weekly shipments are declining as the season is almost complete.

Trees are in good condition and bloom for next season's crop is expected to be good.

CALIFORNIA:. Shipments to date are slightly over half of last season to the same date with the Hass variety showing the most decline. Some windfall and thrip damage is reported. There may have been some loss to the cold weather in December also.
