## AVOCADOS

FLORIDA: The forecast of avocados for certified shipments is continued at 900,000 bushels. This is slightly less than the 938,000 bushels shipped last season. This is the third season shipments have been above 900,000 bushels.

Replacement trees planted since the storm in 1992 are beginning to produce limited amounts of fruit. Bearing acreage statewide is estimated at 6,000 acres, up from 5,700 last season.

Shipments through August are 356,300 bushels, less than last season's early maturity crop but higher than the previous season's level. Maturity levels are near normal with strong demand for large sizes.

CALIFORNIA: Shipments through August total 5,745,000 bushel equivalents. Two months remain in the marketing season.
