AVOCADOS

FLORIDA: The forecast of avocados for certified shipments is 900,000 bushels, unchanged from last month. Hurricane Georges which passed well to the south of Homestead provided gusty winds and varying amounts of rainfall. No tree damage or loss of fruit has been reported.

Shipments through September are 489,000 bushels, less than last season to the same date. Last season's maturity levels were advanced and total shipments were the highest since the 1991-92 season.

CALIFORNIA: Shipments through September total 5,981,000 bushel equivalents. One month remains in the marketing season with total production expected to be less than the 1996-97 season.
