

## **AVOCADOS**

November 10, 1998

FLORIDA: The forecast of avocados for certified shipments is 900,000 bushels, the same as last month. This is less than the last two seasons when slightly over 900,000 bushels were shipped.

Gusty winds and heavy rainfall the first week of November from Tropical Storm Mitch interrupted harvest and caused limited limb breakage. Some fruit was lost but amounts are reported minimal at this time.

Shipments to November 1 are 619,000 bushels, less than last season's advanced crop but near the previous season's level. Demand is reported excellent for large fruit.

CALIFORNIA: Estimated total shipments for the just completed 1997-98 season are 6,083,000 bushel equivalents, slightly less than the previous season. A smaller crop is expected for the 1998-99 season which has just started harvest.

FLORIDA: Estimated certified shipments of avocados, 1998-99 season,
