Citrus Acreage

In combination with the latest commercial citrus tree inventory, bearing, non-bearing, and vacant citrus acreage data was collected and assessed. Bearing acreage is defined as land planted with citrus trees of at least 3 years of age. Non-bearing acreage is defined as land planted with citrus trees less than 3 years of age. Vacant acreage is that land within citrus groves containing dead trees or where space exists for new citrus plantings. Bayheads, ponds, sinkholes, drainage canals lateral and swale ditches, roads, turn rows, and wide middles are excluded in the calculations and determination of bearing and non-bearing acreage. Abandoned acreage is published separately and not included in this report.
