1997 FLORICULTURE AND NURSERY SALES DECLINE 1 PERCENT

Grower sales of Hawaii's flower and nursery products totaled \$68.2 million in 1997. According to the Hawaii Agricultural Statistics Service, the 1997 wholesale value was 1 percent lower than 1996.

Small increases in orchids, foliage, and unspecified sales categories were offset by drops in the wholesale value of other categories. Cut flower value declined 3 percent from 1996, making 1997

the seventh consecutive year of declining values for this general category. Within the cut flower category, anthuriums, red ginger, and heliconias made positive gains over the previous year, a result of increased prices.


Value of orchid sales remained relatively unchanged from 1996. Within this category, potted dendrobiums increased 23 percent to offset declines recorded in all other orchid categories.


The lei flower category, with wholesale sales pegged at \$3.8 million, declined 3 percent. Plumerias and vandas increased sales by 16 percent and 5 percent, respectively.

Foliage sales (potted, cut, and unfinished), pegged at \$17.8 million, were 1 percent higher than 1996. Sales of potted flowering plants were valued at \$3.8 million, a 3 percent decrease from the previous year.

COUNTY RANKINGS:

Hawaii island sales, pegged at \$35.3 million, were 3 percent higher than 1996. Oahu farmers registered sales of \$22.7 million, 10 percent lower than the previous year. Maui/Molokai sales totaled \$8.3 million, 11 percent higher than last year. Kauai sales, pegged at \$1.8 million, were 7 percent lower than 1996.



LANDSCAPE PLANT MATERIAL VALUED AT \$10.7 MILLION

The State's growers of landscape material had sales pegged at \$10.7 million in 1997. This value combines items published elsewhere in this release. It does not include the value of landscape design or installation but only the wholesale value of plant material grown.

Potted foliage for landscape, pegged at \$3.5 million, accounted for 33 percent of the landscape plant material category in 1997. Other landscape plants with a value of \$3.1 million, accounted for 29 percent of the total. Bedding/Garden plants, with \$2.5 million in sales, accounted for 23 percent of the total followed by ornamentals and trees at \$1.6 million.

BIG ISLAND ACCOUNTS FOR MORE THAN HALF OF TOTAL VALUE

Hawaii Island growers accounted for more than one-half of the State's total wholesale value of flower and nursery products in 1997. Big Island's 312 producers generated \$35.3 million in wholesale sales, 3 percent more than 1996. With the exception of cut flowers and all other nursery products, all categories registered increases. Oahu's 202 floriculture and nursery farms reported sales of \$22.7 million. This was 10 percent lower than last year with all categories declining. Maui/Molokai's 106 producers wholesale value of sales topped \$8.3 million, 11 percent higher than a year ago. Kauai's 50 producers generated \$1.8 million in wholesale sales, 7 percent less than 1996.



ANTHURIUM VALUE OF SALES UP

Hawaii's anthurium producers, with total flower and nursery sales of \$10,000 or more (total sales include anthuriums and other crops), registered sales of \$7.4 million in 1997. This was an increase of 5 percent over the \$7.1 million recorded in 1996. The State's 61 commercial farms sold 838,000 dozen, 8 percent fewer than a year ago. Production area, totaling 11.4 million square feet, was 3 percent more than a year ago.


DENDROBIUM ORCHID SALES CLIMB 11 PERCENT

Dendrobium orchid sales in 1997 were pegged at \$9.7 million. This was 11 percent higher than the \$8.7 million posted in 1996. Increase in the potted sector offset declines registered in cut

sprays and individual blossoms.

Potted in bud/bloom, valued at \$5.6 million, represented 58 percent of the total dendrobium

orchid value. Value of sales for pots in bud/bloom increased 22 percent from a year ago and was the highest sales value recorded.

Growers of cut sprays registered \$2.5 million in sales, down 9 percent from the \$2.8 million in 1996. Individual blossoms of dendrobiums were valued at \$725,000, 2 percent less than 1996. Value of community pots, pegged at \$793,000, was 34 percent more than the \$590 recorded in 1996.



production The combined area for dendrobium cut sprays and bud/bloom pots totaled 4.7 million square feet, 12 percent than 1996 for growers with higher \$10,000 or more in total sales (total sales can include crops other than dendrobiums). Production area reported by growers includes newly planted, as well as established acreage; thus, year-to-year yield comparisons calculated using area and sales may be misleading.

Area utilized for cut sprays totaled 3.5 million square feet, 13 percent higher than 1996. Production area for potted in bud/bloom totaled 1.2 million square feet, 11 percent more than last year.

U.S. FLORICULTURE VALUED AT \$3.42 BILLION

The value of floriculture crops continued to increase in 1997. The total value of all crops at wholesale for all growers with \$10,000 or more in sales is estimated at \$3.57 billion for 1997, compared with \$3.41 billion in 1996. California continued as the leading state with crops valued at \$746 million, up 11 percent for the year. Florida recorded a 3 percent decline in its output as the 1997 wholesale value of sales fell to \$654 million. These two states accounted for 39 percent of the total value. Of the 36 states surveyed, 26 recorded higher value and 10 showed decreases. The top five states--California, Florida, Michigan,

Texas, and Ohio--accounted for \$1.92 billion, 54 percent of the total value. Growers with sales exceeding \$100,000 for the year accounted for 93 percent of the total, at \$3.33 billion. This size group comprised 49 percent of the total number of growers.

The number of floriculture growers continued to fall as the count in 1997 was 9,666, down 404

from the number in 1996. The number of growers with sales of \$100,000 or more in sales rose from 4,683 in 1996 to 4,722 in 1997.

The use of hired workers decreased in 1997. A total of 8,204 operations reported hired workers during the year, compared with 8,472 reporting hired

workers a year earlier. Overall, 85 percent of the operations used some hired workers in 1997, compared with 84 percent in 1996. The average number of hired workers used during peak times, at 13.4, was marginally lower than the previous year's average of 13.5 workers.


The total wholesale value of floriculture crops grown by operations exceeding the \$100,000 minimum sales level reached \$3.33 billion in 1997, a 6 percent increase over the \$3.15 billion for 1996. Values for all crop categories rose in 1997, except for cut cultivated greens. Bedding and garden plants, the largest contributor, recorded a 10 percent increase in wholesale value to \$1.57 billion. Flowering potted plants recorded a 2 percent boost over the previous year reaching \$701 million. Foliage also gained 2 percent in value at \$522 million. Value of cut flowers grew 6 percent, but cut cultivated greens were down 11 percent.

Where does Hawaii rank? For producers with \$100,000 or more in total sales, Hawaii's cut flower wholesale value of sales ranked 4th behind California, Florida, and Colorado. Hawaii's foliage for indoor or patio use growers also ranked 4th in the nation behind Florida, California, and Texas.

OUT-OF-STATE SALES 8 PERCENT HIGHER

The value of out-of-State sales of flowers and nursery products (including wholesale and retail sales) during 1997 was estimated at \$41.4 million. Values in this table are not comparable to values shown in the majority of other tables throughout this release. The value of out-of-State sales represents the dollar received at the point the commodity leaves the State. Thus, the product contains retail and wholesale sales and may include multiple transactions by the time it leaves the State.



Anthuriums remained the number one floriculture crop or nursery product exported. The \$10.9 million value was 13 percent higher than 1996. Potted foliage followed at \$10.3 million, 9 percent higher than a year ago. Other potted orchids moved into third with \$5.4 million in value, 35 percent higher than the previous year. Dendrobium sprays decreased 14 percent from 1996. The \$3.5 million generated by potted dendrobium orchids ranked fifth in out-of-State sales.



VALUE OF ANTHURIUM EXPORTS ROSE IN 1997

Out-of-State anthurium sales were estimated at \$10.9 million for 1997, 13 percent higher than 1996. The out-of-State value includes wholesale and retail sales and is a relative gauge of sales outside of the State of Hawaii.

Out-of-State shipments from the Big Island, which produces more than 99 percent of the State's anthuriums, totaled 703,300 dozen in 1997. Big Island's total out-of-State shipments were 4 percent more than 1996. Mainland destinations, which made



up about 54 percent of the Big Island's exports, were 2 percent higher than 1996. Foreign shipments increased 7 percent from the previous year.

Note: Big Island shipment figures include production from growers with less than \$10,000 in total floriculture and nursery sales. Big Island shipment figures are not comparable to production values published in Island Summary tables, page 11. Big Island shipment figures are also not comparable with value of out-of-State anthurium shipments, page 14.



TOTAL DENDROBIUM EXPORTS UNCHANGED

Export dendrobium sales totaled \$7.1 million in 1997, relatively unchanged from 1996. Potted dendrobium exports registered \$3.5 million. The 18 percent increase in potted dendrobium exports was enough to offset a 13 percent drop in export sales of cut sprays.
