1998 FLORICULTURE AND NURSERY SALES HIT RECORD HIGH

Grower sales of Hawaii's flower and nursery products totaled a record \$72.5 million in 1998. According to the Hawaii Agricultural Statistics Service, the 1998 wholesale value was 9 percent higher than the \$66.7 million reported in 1997. Cut flowers, orchids, and potted flowering plant categories registered increases in 1998.

The state's leading cut flower remains the anthurium. However, a decrease in price combined with stagnant sales resulted in a 9 percent decline in value compared to a year earlier.

STATE SUMMARY (Continued)


Value of orchid sales increased 3 percent from 1997. Potted dendrobiums, which includes the community pots and bud/bloom, dropped 5 percent in overall value due to a drop in the community pot sector.

The lei flower category, with wholesale sales pegged at \$3.5 million, declined 9 percent. Sales of potted flowering plants were valued at \$3.9 million, a 4 percent increase over 1997.


COUNTY RANKINGS:

Hawaii island sales, pegged at \$38.4 million, were 11 percent higher than 1997. Oahu farmers registered sales of \$23.9 million, 8 percent higher than the previous year. Maui/Molokai sales totaled \$8.8 million, 8 percent higher than last year. Kauai sales, pegged at \$1.4 million, 24 percent lower than 1997.

The results in this report are based upon the decennial Census of Horticultural Specialties. The survey questionnaire contained the traditional questions about floriculture production plus detailed questions about horticultural commodities in general.

Combining the Floricultural Survey with the Horticultural Specialties Survey resulted in several procedural changes:

The more detailed questionnaire allowed respondents to more accurately identify the specific types of crops produced. In some instances, products may have been miss-categorized between floriculture versus horticulture in previous years.

Production area is no longer collected or published for flats and potted flowering plants or bedding/garden plants.



VALUED AT \$10.5 MILLION

The State's growers of landscape material had sales pegged at \$10.5 million in 1998. This value combines items published elsewhere in this release. It does not include the value of landscape design or installation but only the wholesale value of plant material grown.

BIG ISLAND ACCOUNTS FOR MORE THAN HALF OF TOTAL VALUE

Hawaii Island growers of flowers and nursery products once again accounted for over one half of the state's total wholesale value of flowers and nursery products in 1998. Big Island's 355 growers rang up sales of \$38.4 million, up 11 percent from the \$34.5 million in 1997. All categories with the exception of lei flowers and foliage registered increases. Oahu's 205 producers accounted for about one third of the state's total wholesale value of flowers and nursery products. Oahu farmers reported sales of \$23.9 million, 8 percent higher than 1997. Maui/Molokai's 145 producers generated \$8.8 million in wholesale sales, 8 percent higher than the \$8.2 million generated in 1997. Kauai's 40 producers registered \$1.4 million in wholesale sales, 24 percent lower than a year earlier.



ANTHURIUM VALUE OF SALES LOWER

Hawaii's anthurium producers, with total flower and nursery sales of \$10,000 or more (total sales include anthuriums and other crops), registered sales of \$6.3 million in 1998. This was a 9 percent decline from the \$6.9 million recorded in 1997. The State's 75 commercial anthurium farms sold 834,000 dozen, 10 percent more than a year ago. Production area, totaling 11.3 million square feet, was 1 percent lower than 1997.




DENDROBIUM ORCHID SALES 3 PERCENT HIGHER

1998 Dendrobium orchid sales were pegged at \$9.9 million, 3 percent higher than the \$9.7 million posted in 1997.

Potted in bud/bloom, valued at \$5.7 million, represented 57

percent of the total dendrobium orchid value. Value of sales for pots in bud/bloom increased 1 percent from a year ago and was the highest sales value recorded. Growers of cut sprays registered \$3.0




million in sales, rising 18 percent above the \$2.5 million in 1997. Individual blossoms of dendrobiums were valued at \$855,000, 18 percent more than 1997. Value of community pots, pegged at \$406,000, was 49 percent lower than 1997.

DENDROBIUM PRODUCTION AREA 13 PERCENT HIGHER

The combined production area for dendrobium cut sprays and bud/bloom pots totaled 5.3 million square feet, 13 percent higher than 1997 for growers with \$10,000 or more in total sales (total sales can include crops other than dendrobiums). Production area reported by growers includes newly planted, as well as established acreage; thus, year-to-year yield comparisons calculated using area and sales may be misleading.

HAWAII DENDROBIUM ORCHIDS (Continued)

Area utilized for cut sprays totaled 3.29 million square feet, 6 percent lower than 1997. Production area for potted in bud/bloom totaled 1.97 million square feet, 69 percent more than last year.
