Farm production at record high

The Hawaii Agricultural Statistics Service estimates production of fresh herb sales at a record high 4.2 million pounds for 2002, up 30 percent from 2001. Although average farm prices declined in response to the higher output, total farm revenues rose to a record high \$7.0 million.


Sweet (Italian) basil production increased 33 percent to a record high 2.0 million pounds. Farm prices declined 3 percent to an average of \$1.95 per pound. Sales of **Asian basil** totaled 1.0 million pounds, up 54 percent from 2001 and a new record high for this herb. Farm prices averaged 85 cents per pound in 2002, up 6 percent from 2001.

Parsley production is estimated at 300,000 pounds for 2002, down 9 percent from 2001. Farm prices averaged \$1.70 per pound, down 15 percent from 2001. **Chinese parsley** (more commonly known as Cilantro) sales tripled to 300,000 pounds in 2002. The record output resulted in a decline in farm prices to an average of \$1.50 per pound in 2002, down 29 percent from 2001.

Production of all **other herbs** totaled 550,000 pounds and had a farm value of \$1.3 million in 2002. Mint, chives, arugula, and rosemary are some of the major herbs in this combined category. Separate totals for these herbs were not published to avoid disclosure of individual operations. •
