

SEPTEMBER FRESH PAPAYAS DOWN 11 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR

Hawaii fresh papaya utilization is estimated at 2.5 million pounds for September 2008, up 12 percent from August 2008, but down 11 percent from September a year ago. Sales for January to September of this year totaled 22.5 million pounds, 2 percent above the comparable period last year.

Total in crop acreage for September 2008 is estimated at 2,205, up 8 percent from June and 5 percent more than September 2007. Harvested area totaled 1,280 acres in September, decreasing 4 and 7 percent from June 2008 and September 2007, respectively.

Weather for September was mainly humid and sunny with scattered showers, heavy at times. Flowering was steady and fruit development improved slightly in some fields. Gaps in the fruit columns were becoming more evident after experiencing continuous dry weather. Regular spraying programs kept pests and weeds controlled. Crop condition was generally fair to good. Large fields were being processed for replanting.

Papaya growers are expected to receive an estimated 47.0 cents per pound for fresh fruit in September, 6 percent (3.0 cents) less than last month, but 27 percent (9.9 cents) more than September 2007.
